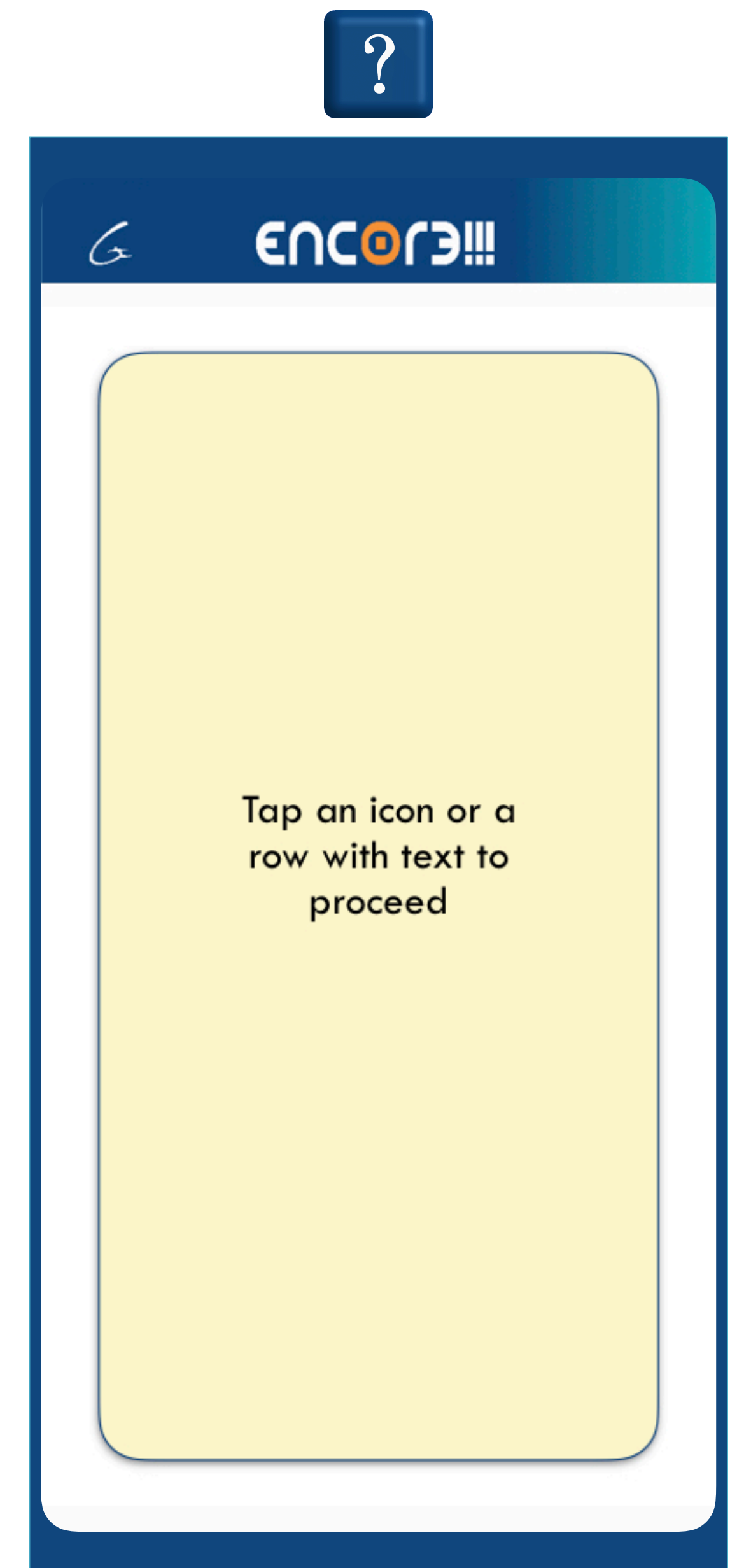
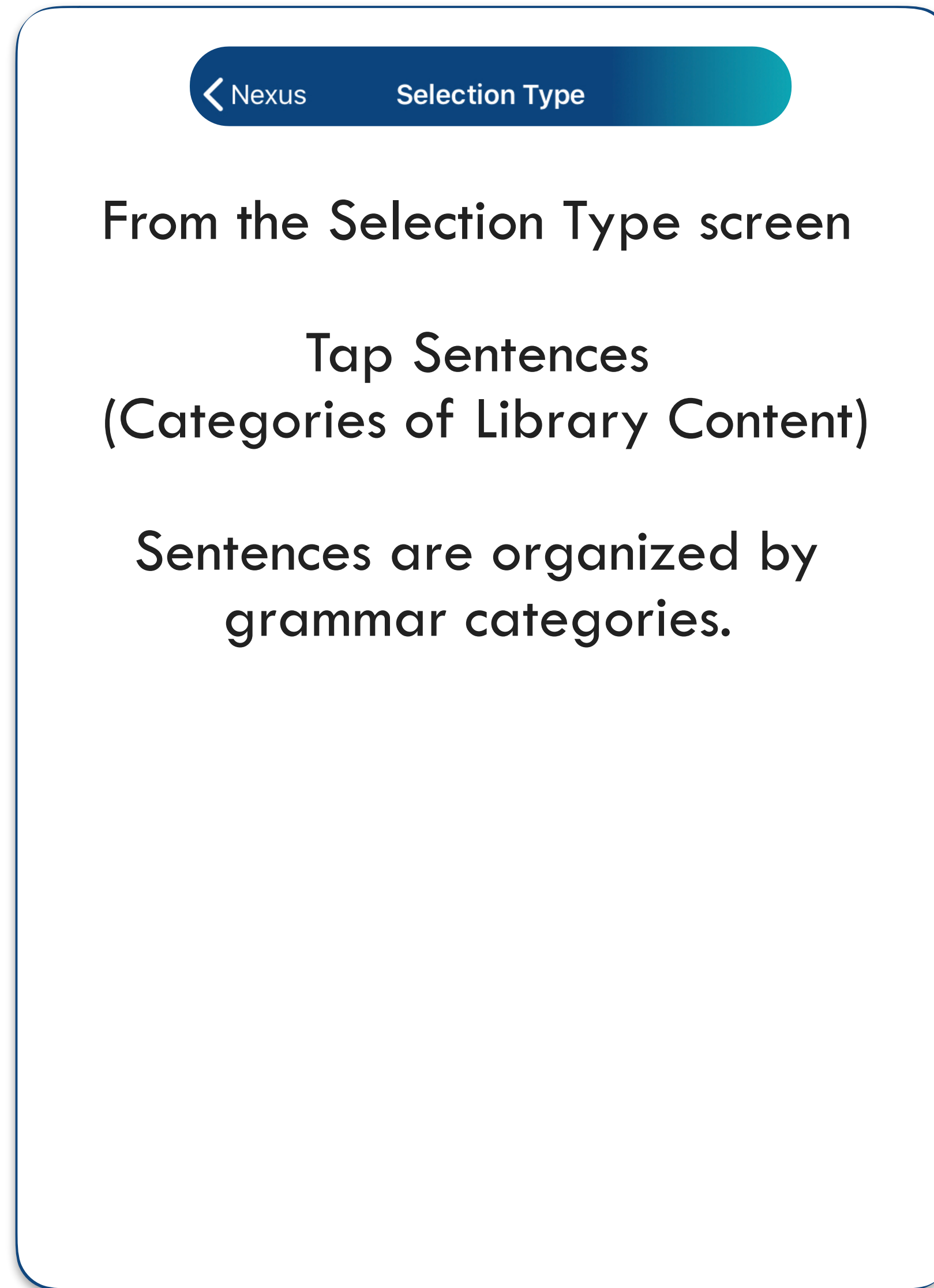
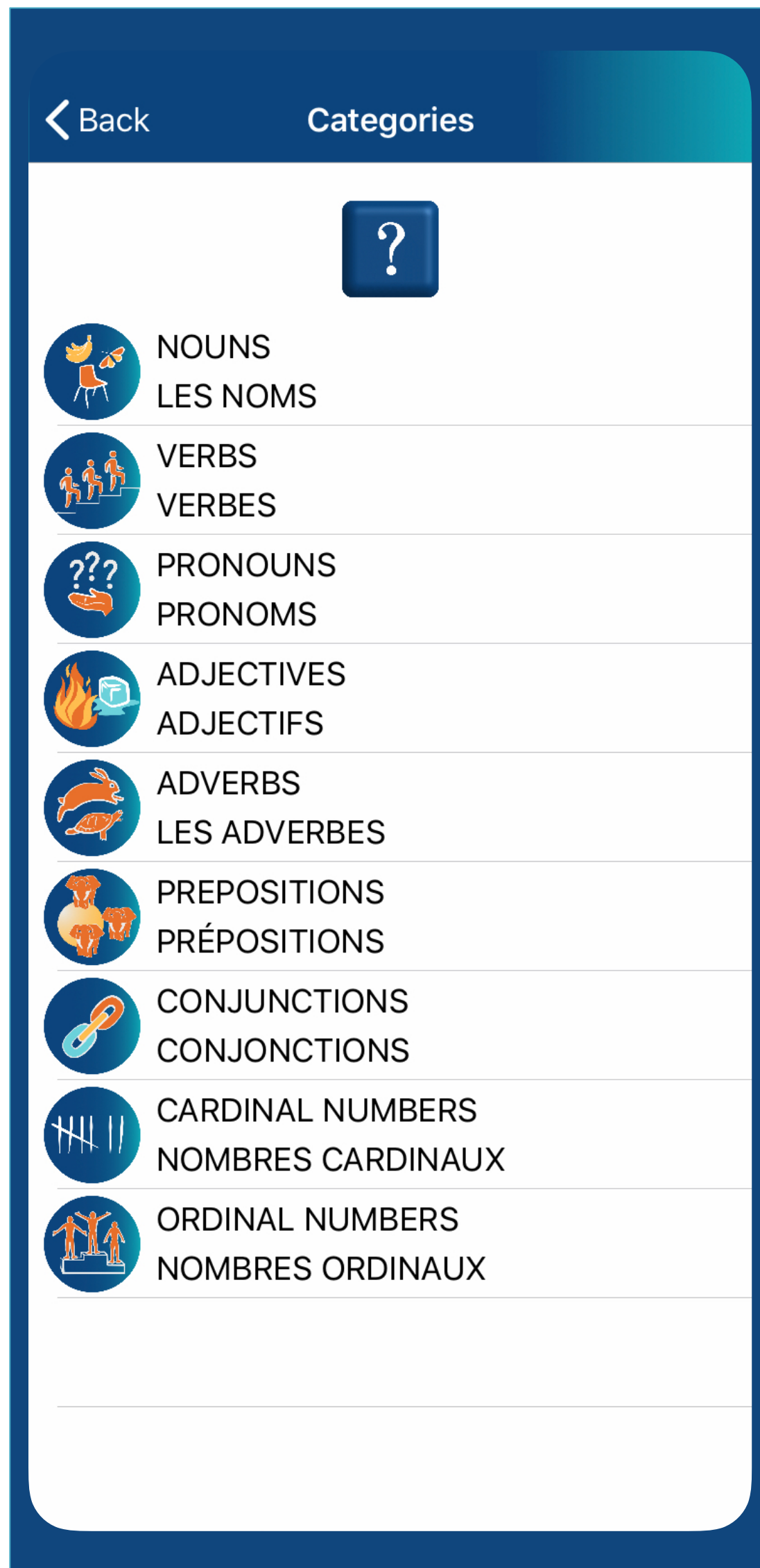
## LIBRARY CONTENTS

- Vocabulary: ~2,450 words (nouns, pronouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, prepositions, conjunctions, cardinal and ordinal numbers) allows the user to comprehend ~90% of the language used in daily life.
- Grammar Guide: ~150 sentences to illustrate proper grammar usage for each language.
- Verb Conjugations: examples show how verb forms may change with a given language.
- ~1,650 Sentences covering everyday language needs, plus ~4,550 words used in each sentence.
- Greetings and Useful Phrases: (~200) introductions, shopping, obtaining transport, ordering food, dealing with emergencies, etc.

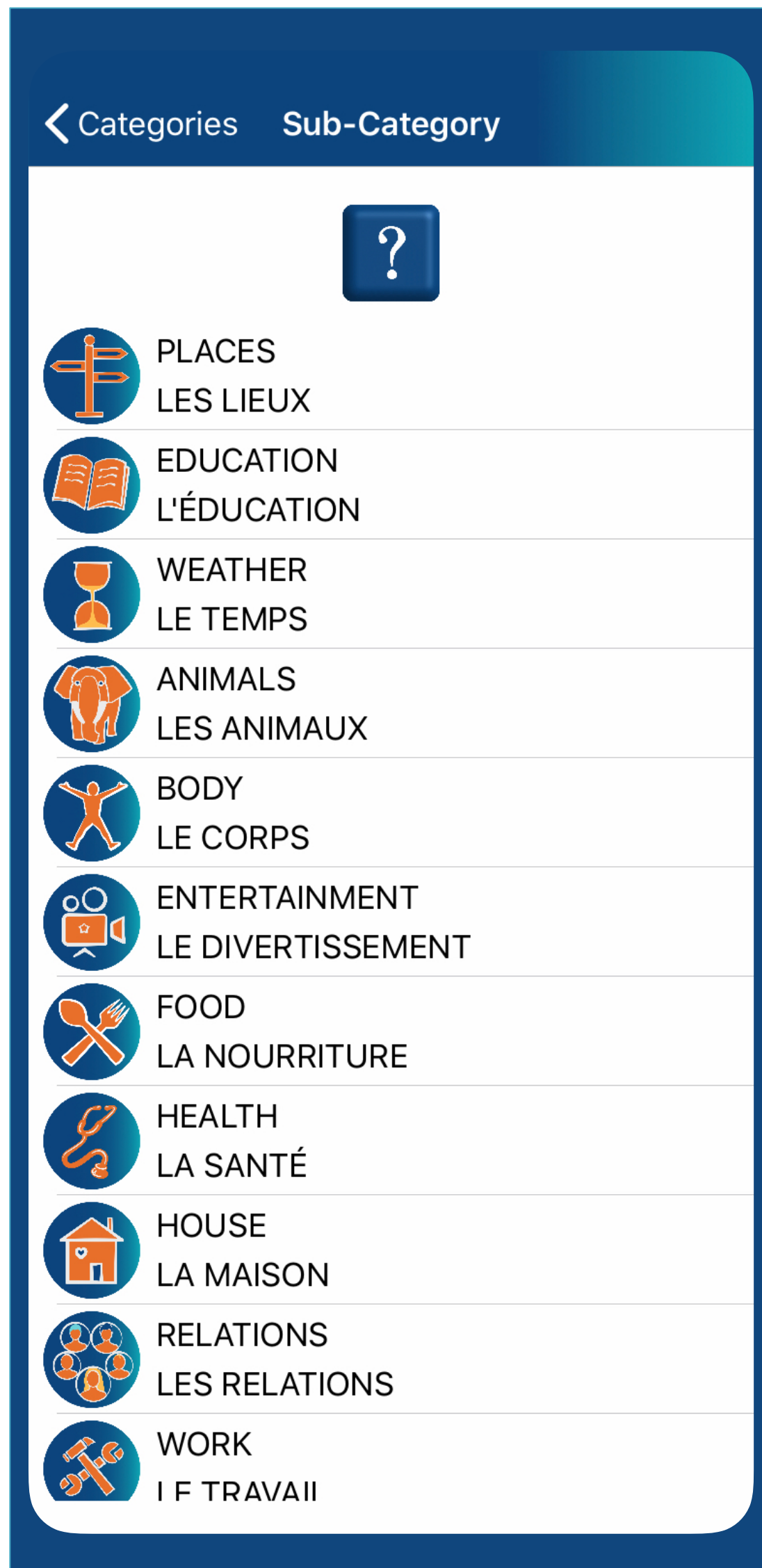

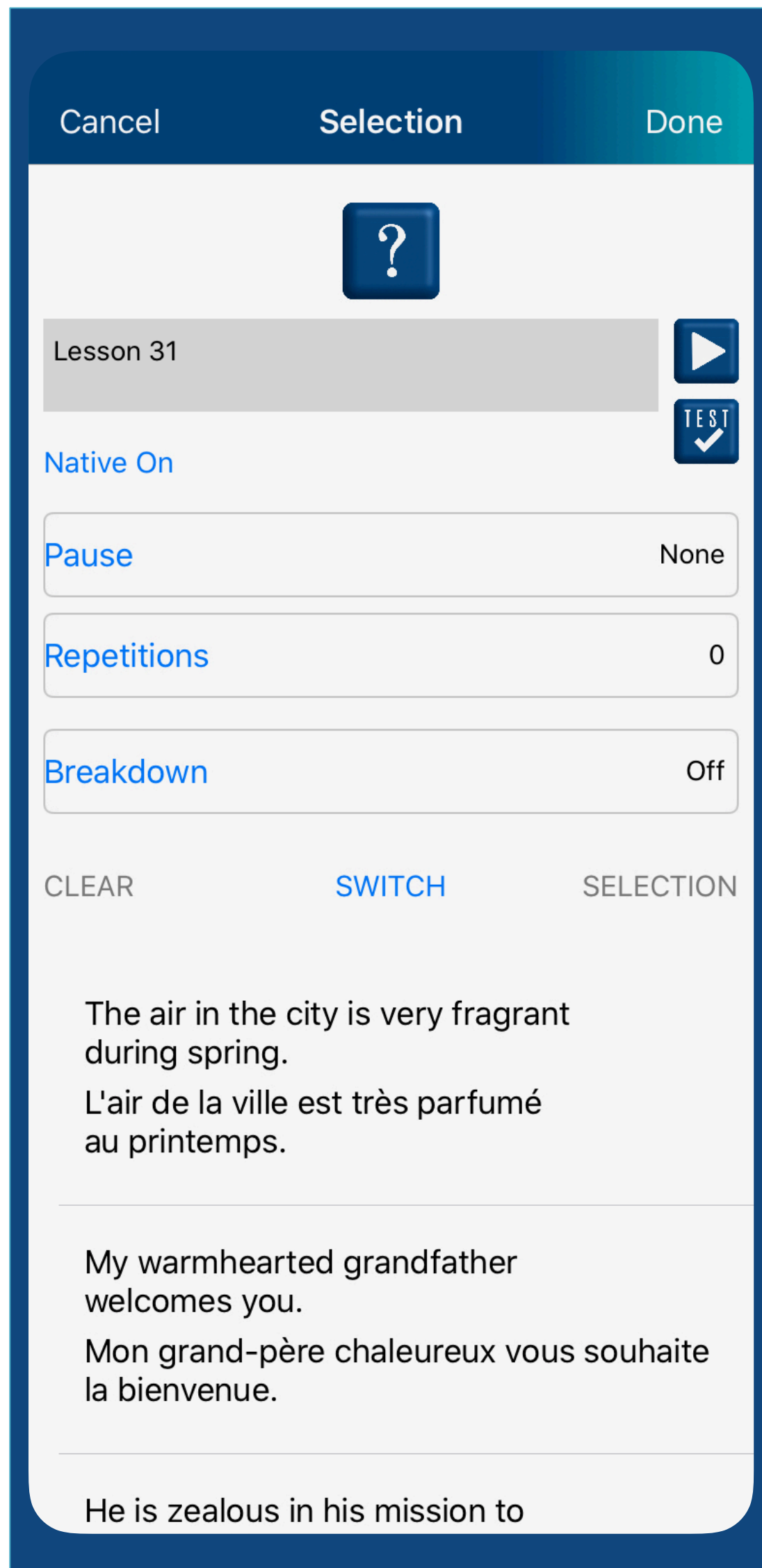
## Edit/Done Selection screen (these toggle when tapped)

In Edit mode (Done is displayed) you can tap **SWITCH** to change the order of the languages.

You can also tap **Native On** and it will change to **Native Off**. With **Native Off** you will only hear the second language (the target language).

**Native On/Off** choice can be made in both the Edit mode and in the Done mode.





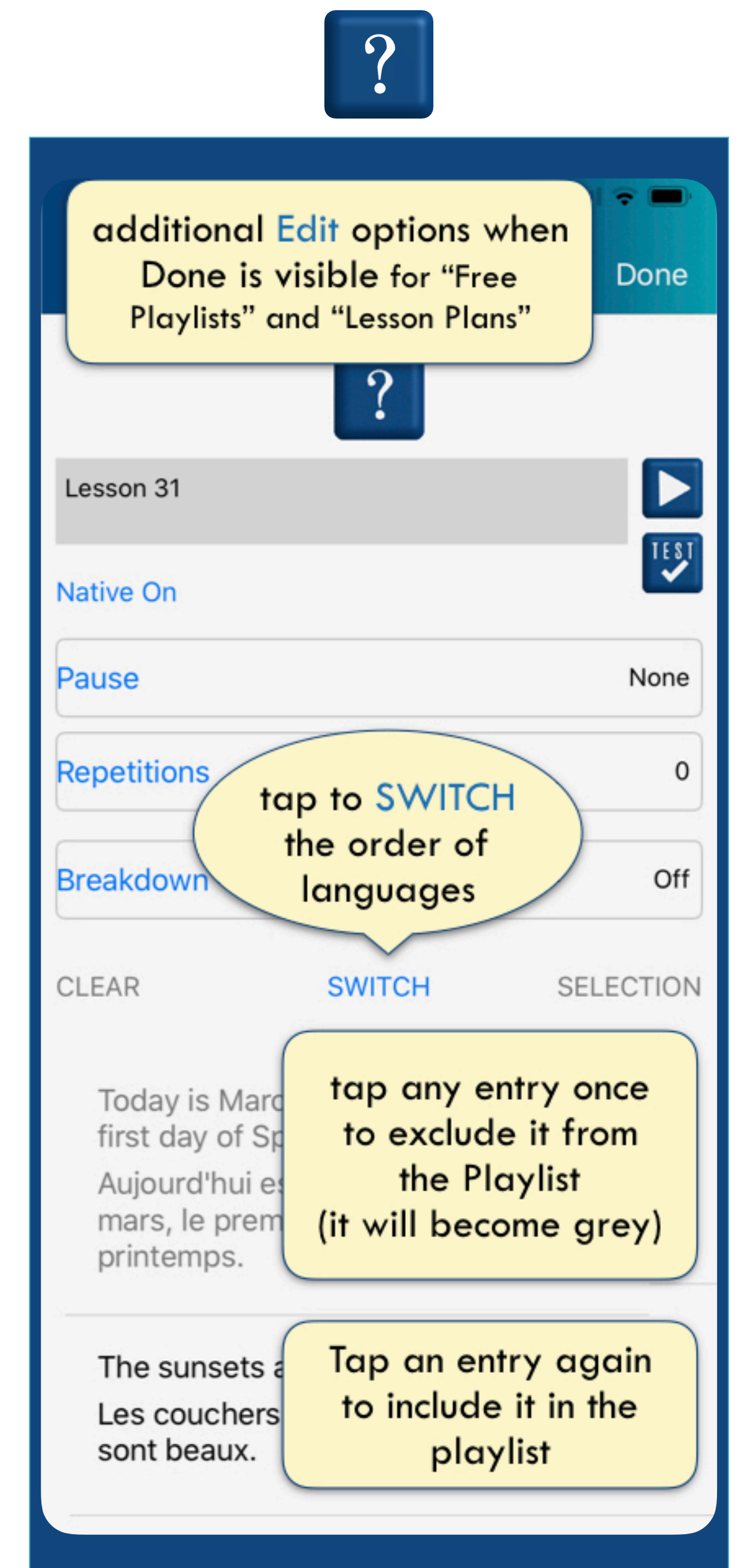

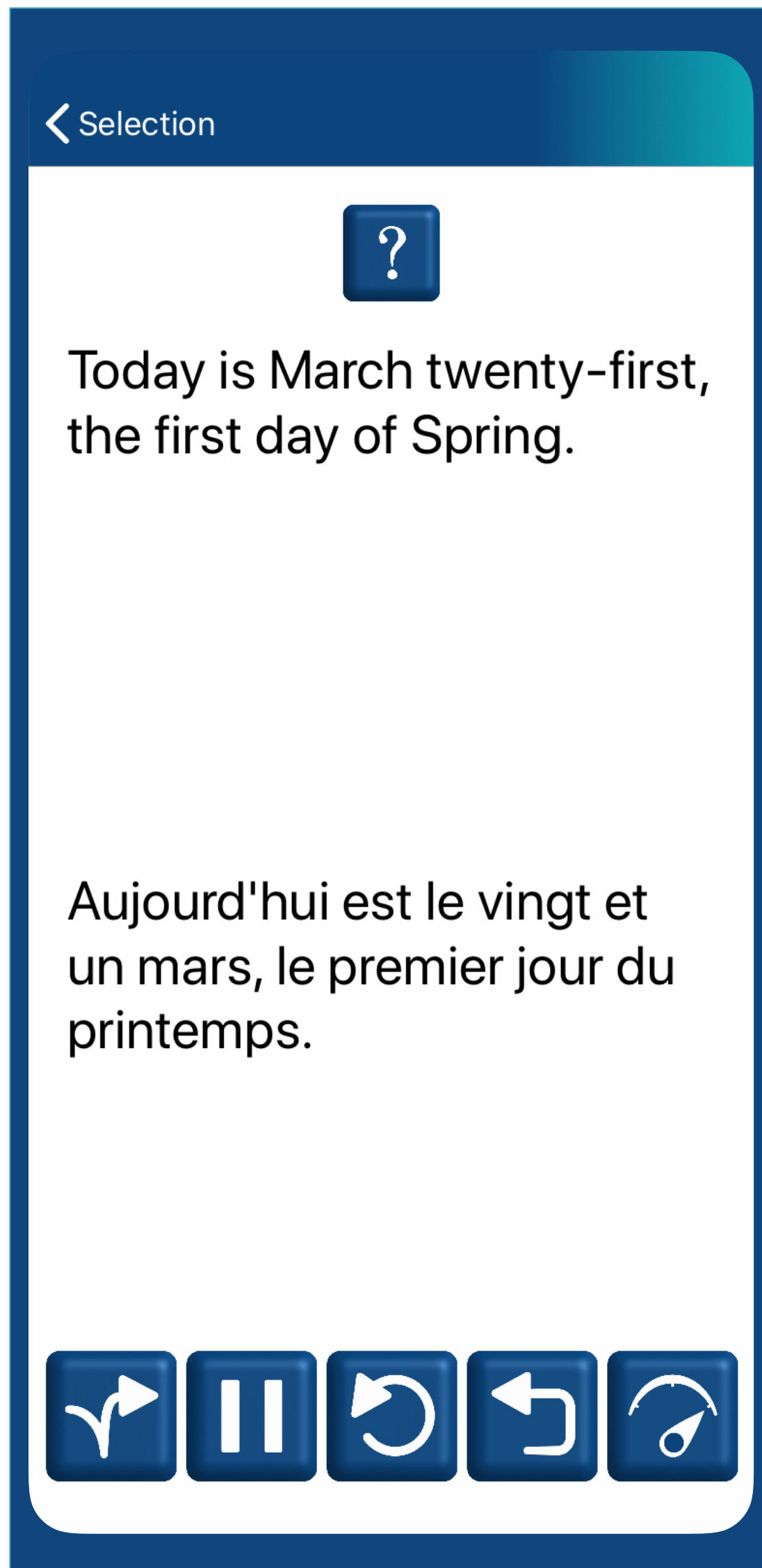
The 1st Language is vocalized once and then the selected pause is given.

The 2nd Language is then vocalized and repeated multiple times according to the selections made for the Playlist.




Both languages and the applicable transliteration is then displayed for each entry.










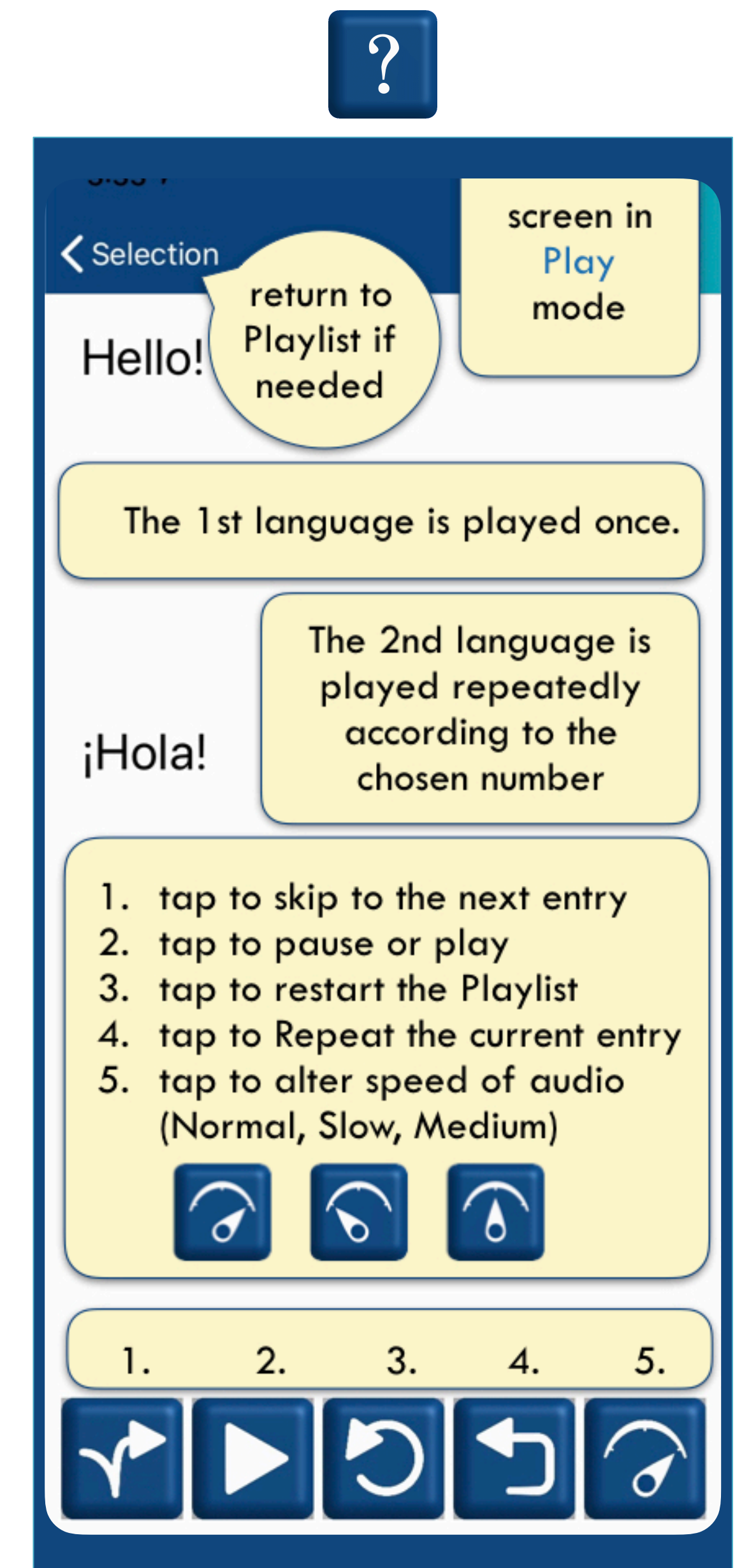


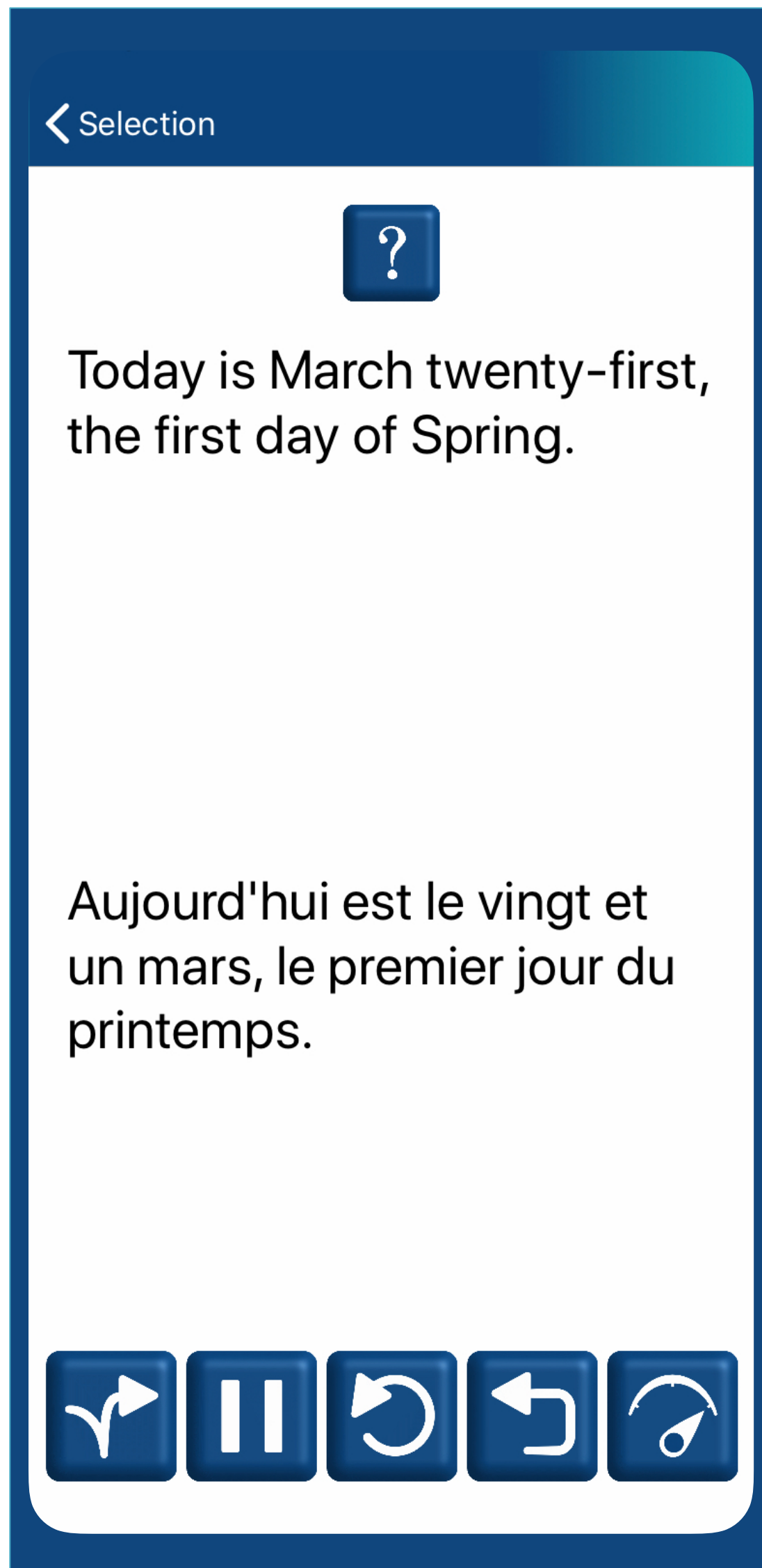
## Options During Play

-  Skip to the next entry.
-  Repeat the second language audio again.
-  Return to the beginning of the Playlist.

-  Normal speed (default)
-  Slowest speed
-  Slow speed

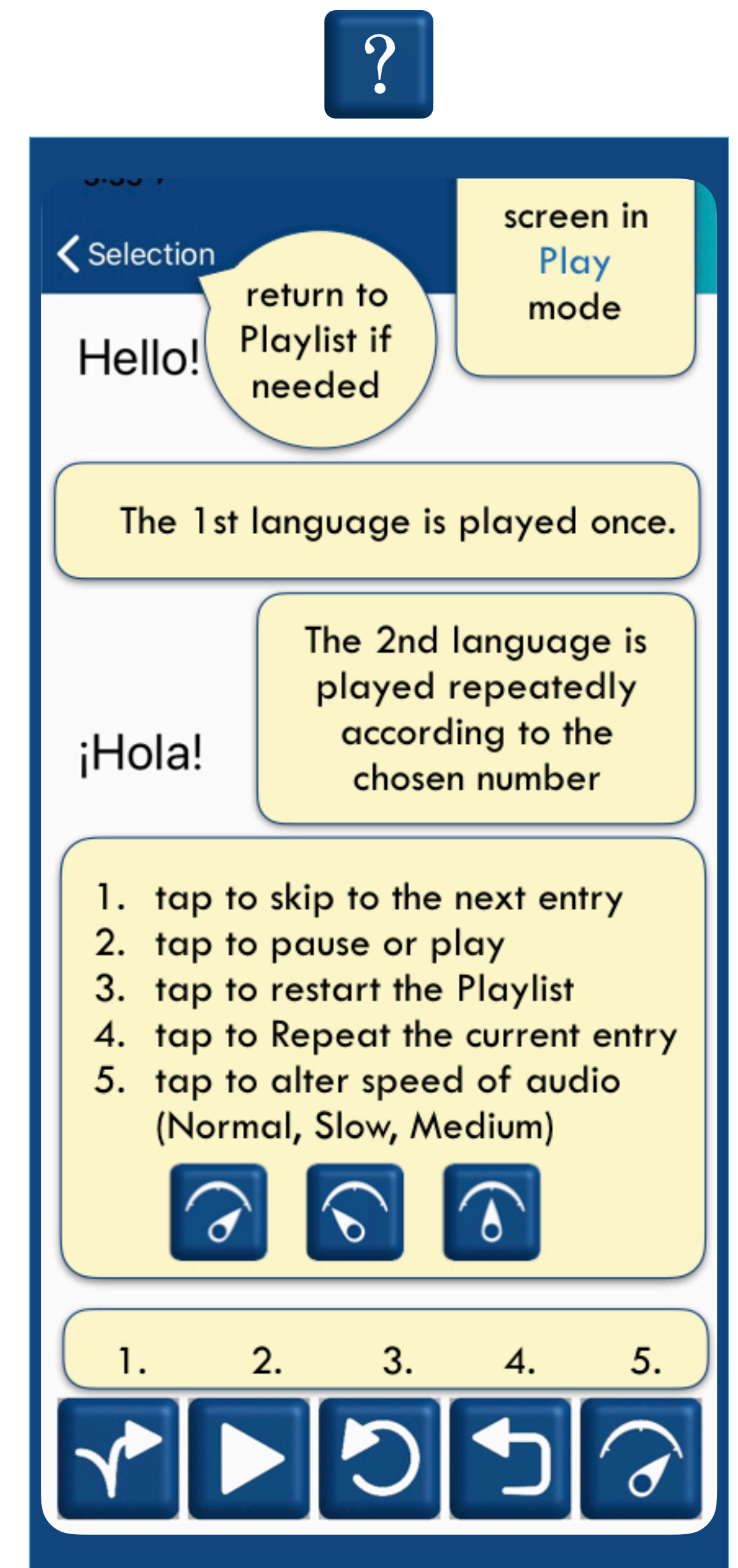




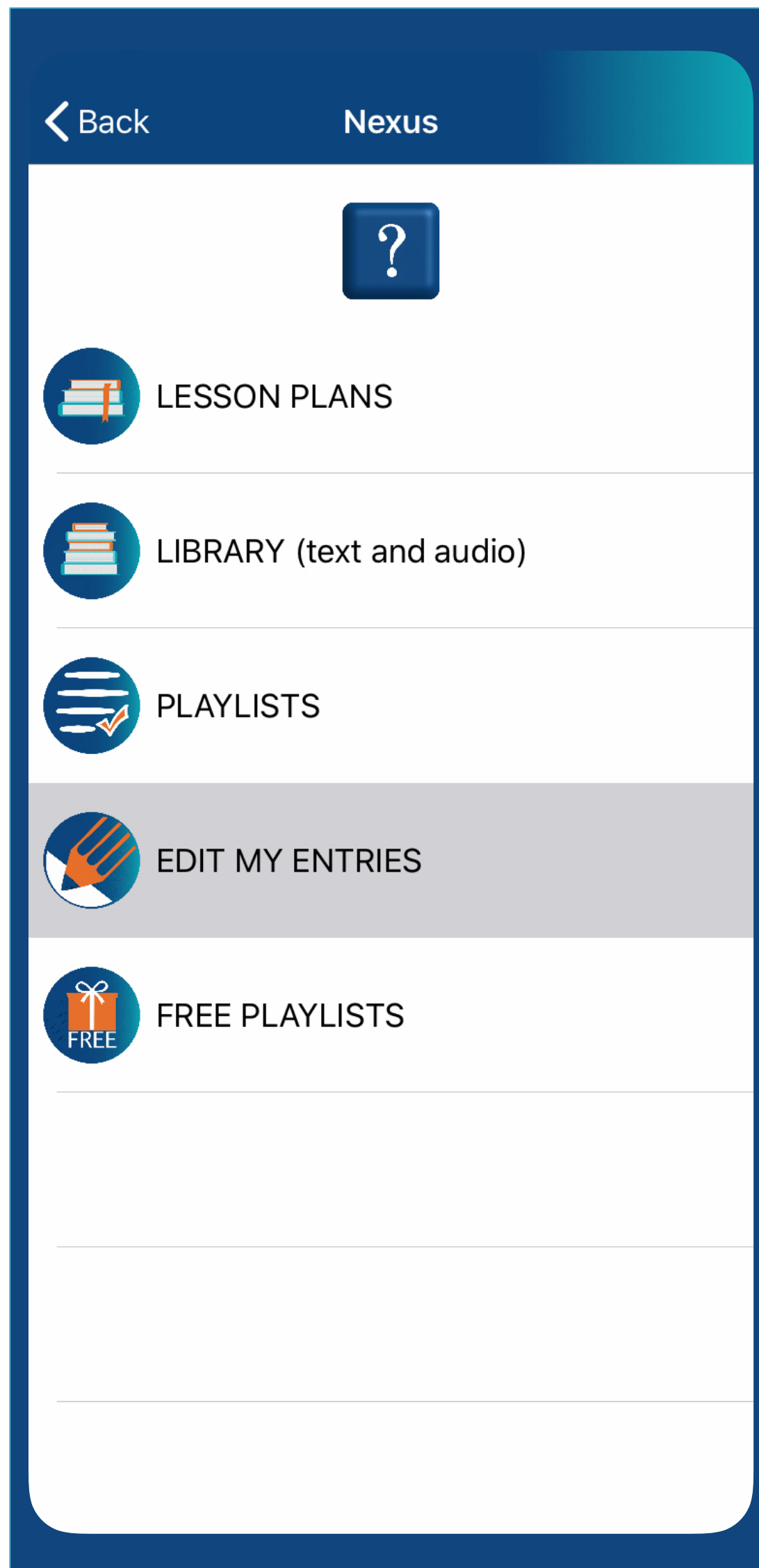
## Options During Play

The length of pause between the two languages allows the listener to time to think of and then repeat an entry. The repetitions give the opportunity to memorize the entries.

At any time the playlist can be paused. When “Play” is tapped the playlist starts from the beginning of the paused entry.







The upgraded version of Encore!!! allows you to expand your Library by adding your own content.

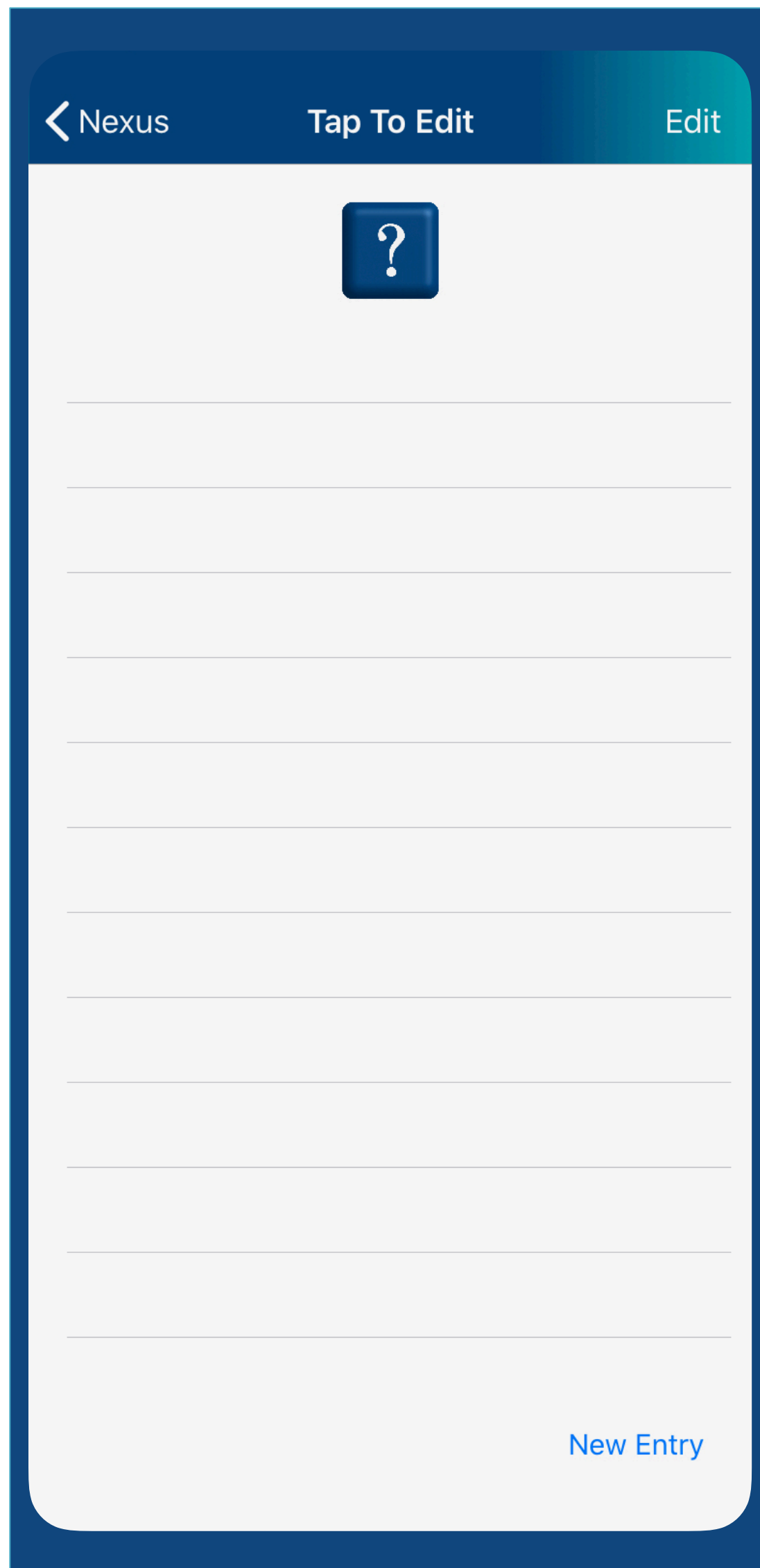

### Voice-Recorder Feature

**My Entries** feature allows you to add your audio content to customize your own app. Choose vocal files to learn songs, dialogues, poems, verb conjugations...

## Select Edit My Entries

There are 3 text boxes:  
Native, Foreign and Other.  
Enter content in the first two, or

## Select Edit My Entries

Once you have entered your content in the My Entry text boxes correctly tap NEXT

(at the bottom of the text boxes screen). Your entries will be displayed on a new screen.

Tap the “speaker” symbol to hear the text vocalized by the synthesized voice (if this feature is available for the language you have chosen.\*)

The text you place in the 2nd text box will be synthesized using the 2nd language.

For example, if you place text in English in the second text box for an English-French choice you will hear it with a French accent.

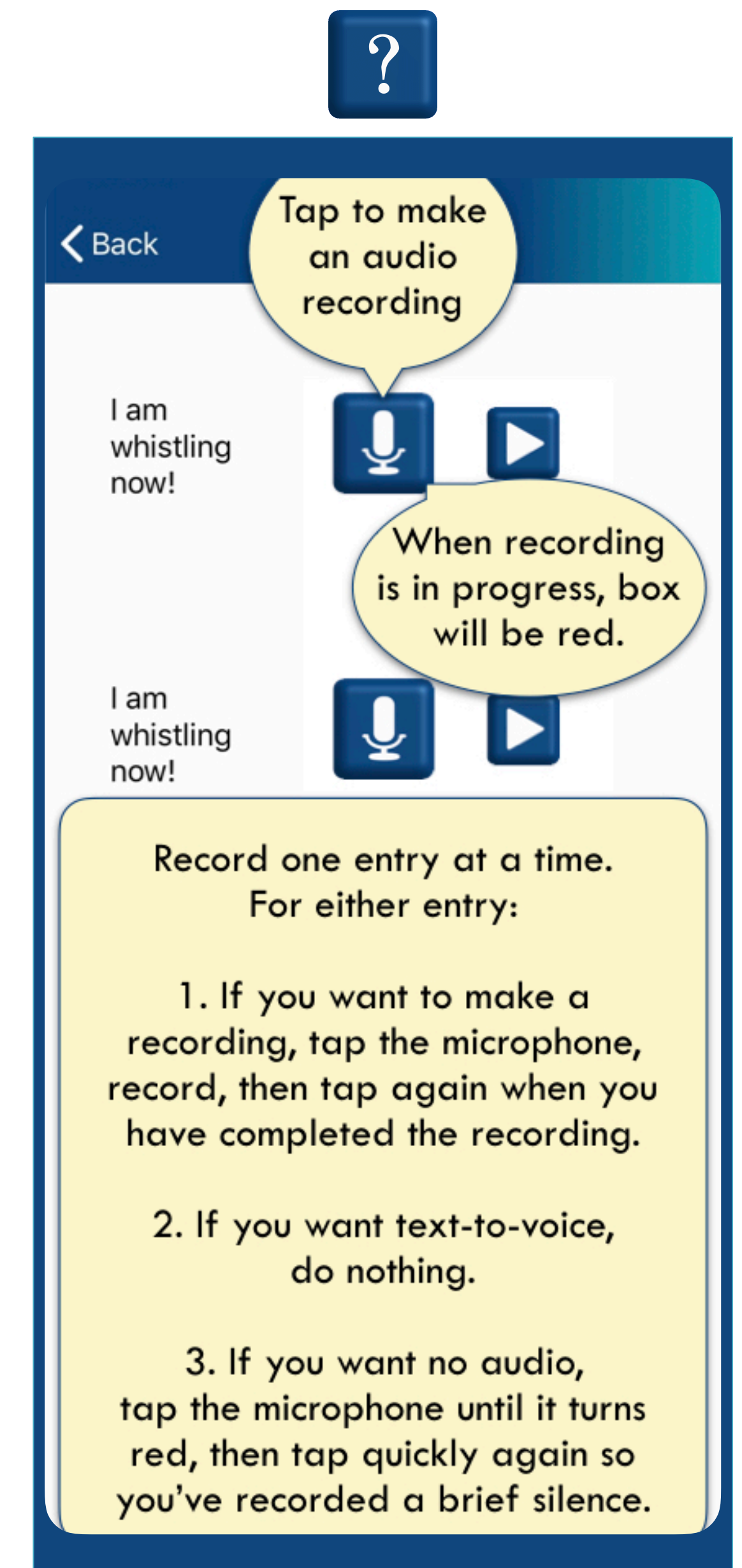


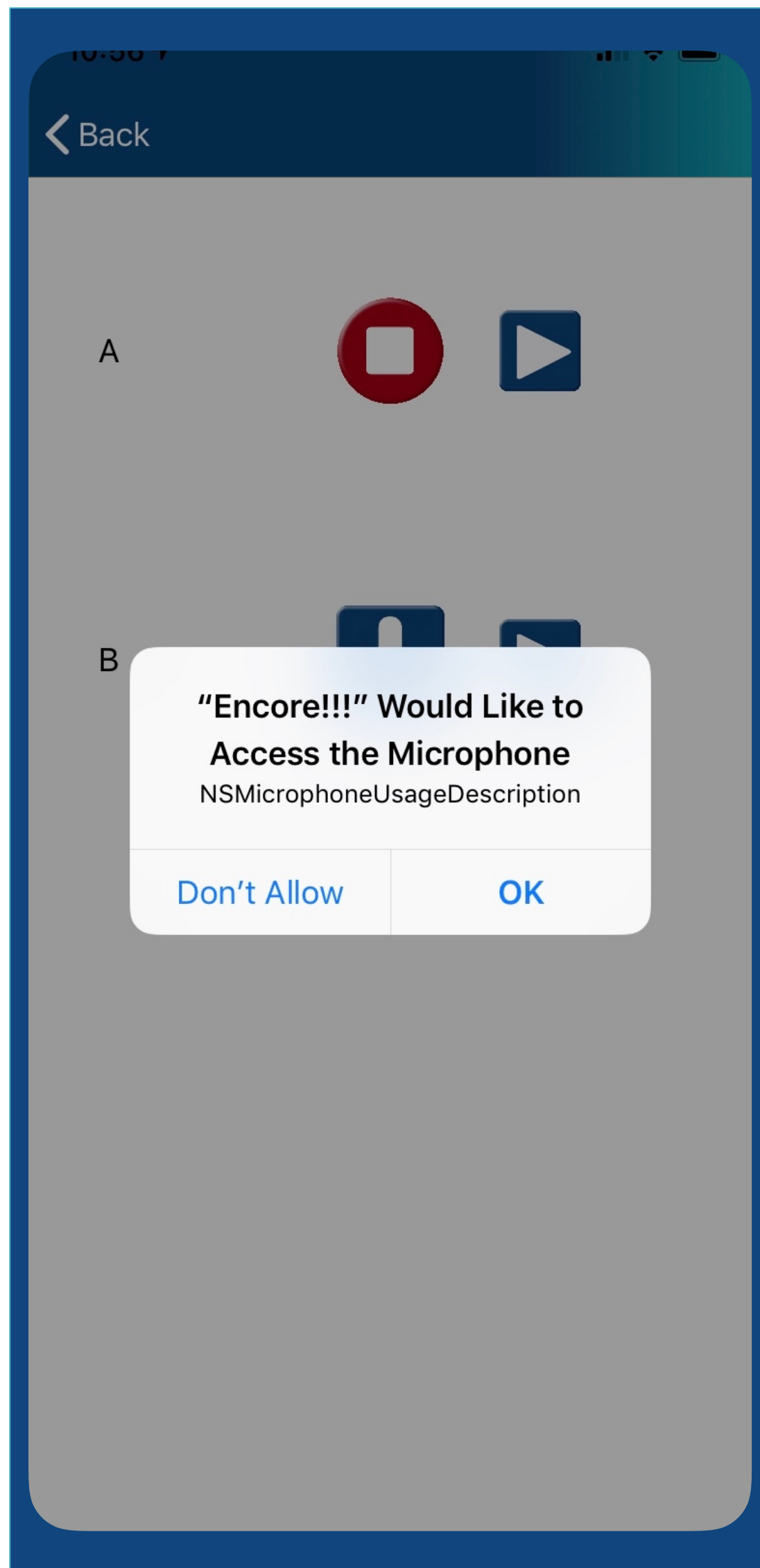


If you choose to record from an external source

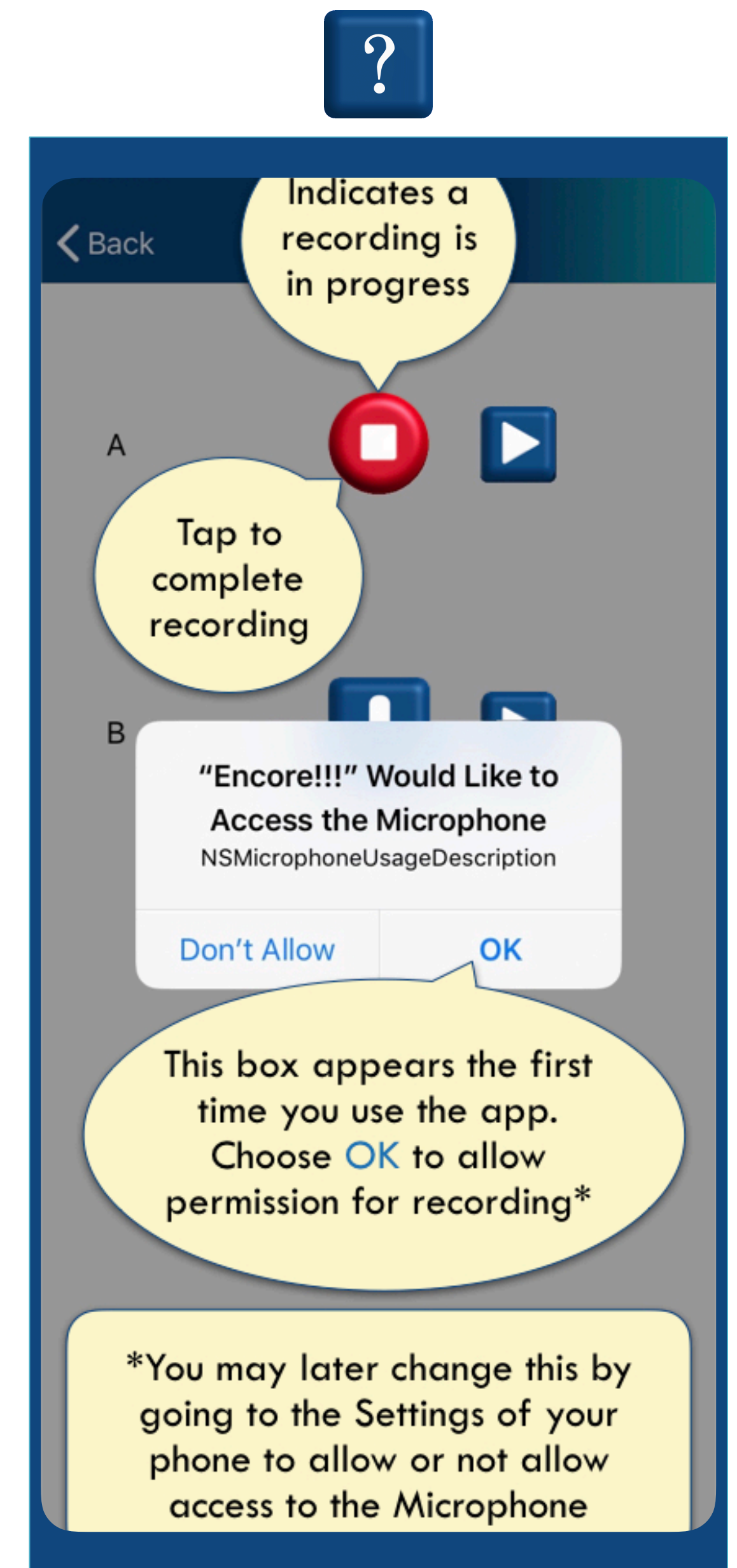

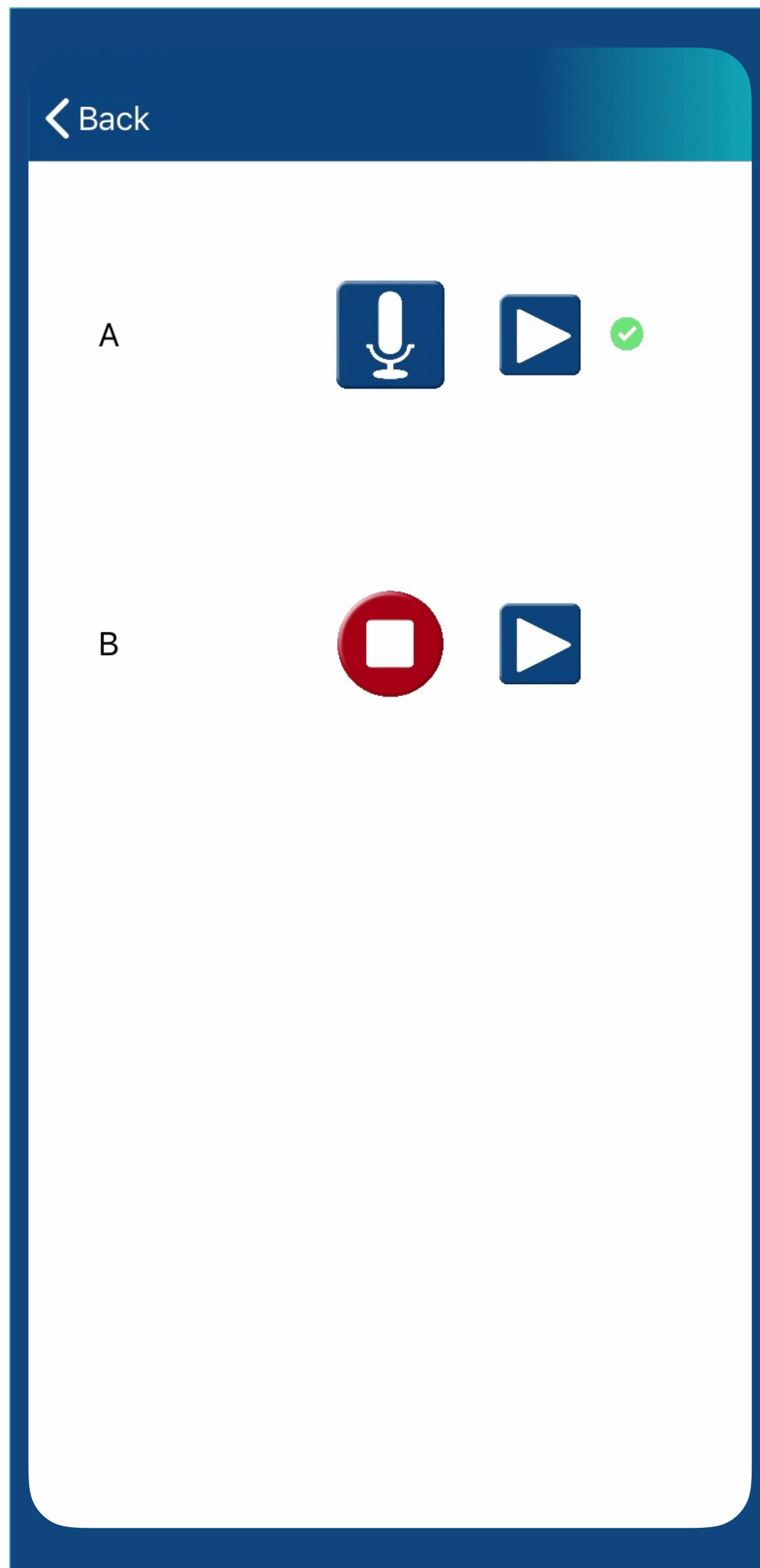


If you are recording for the first time, you may be asked if you allow Encore!!! to use your device microphone. Choose "Yes" to allow recording.  
If you choose "Don't Allow" you will not be able to do any external recording.

(You may change this later in the Settings on your device)



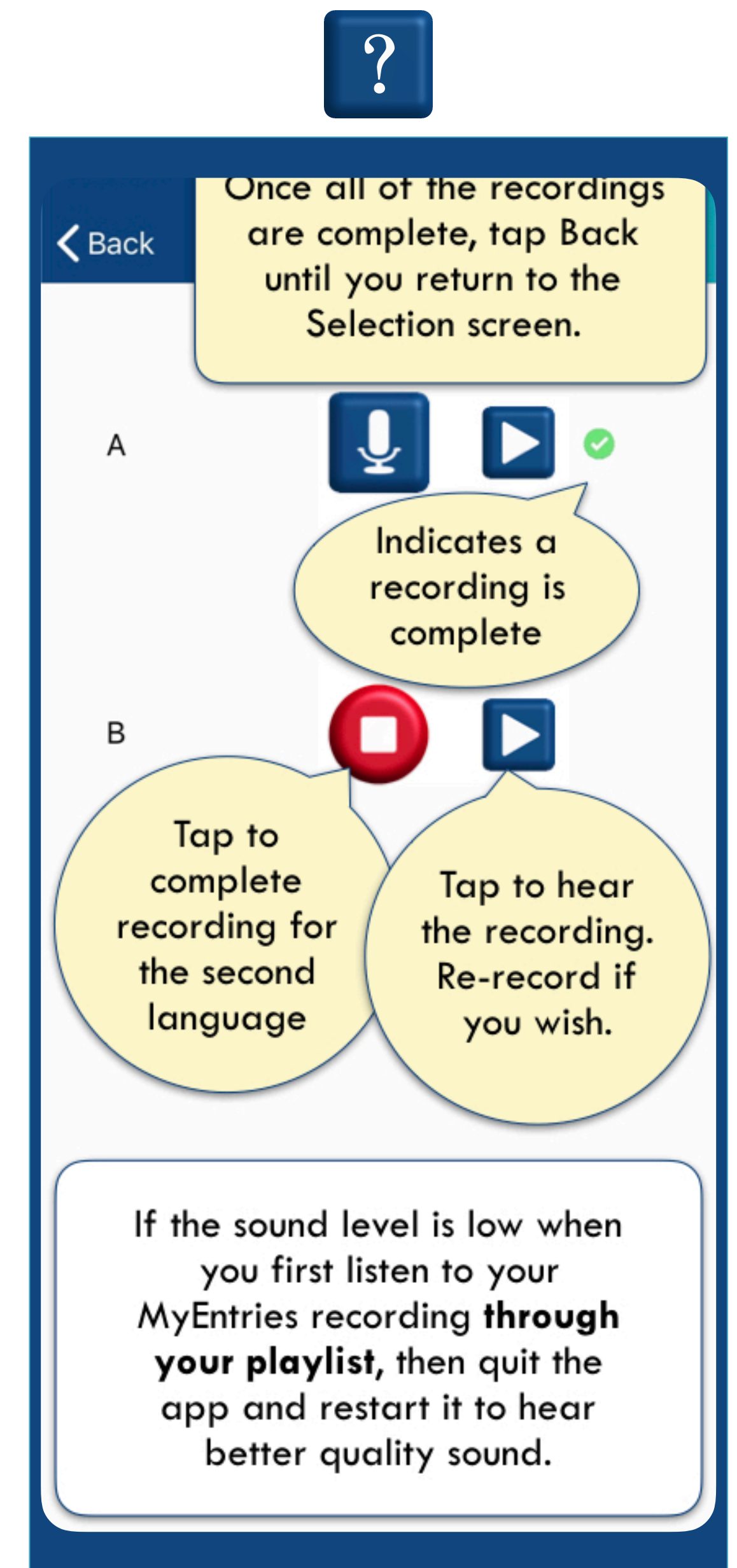


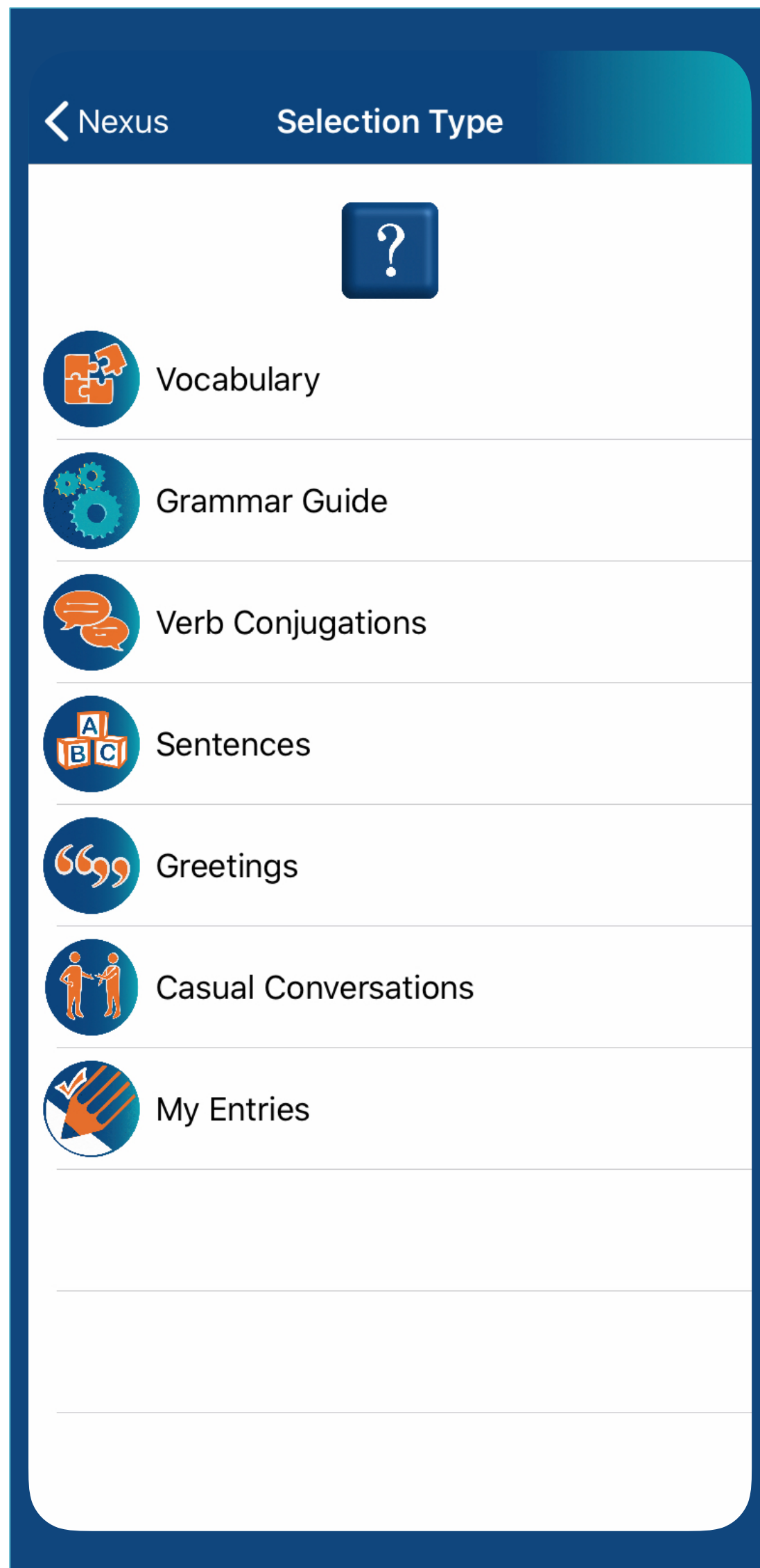


Tap a microphone to record.

If you do not use the microphone

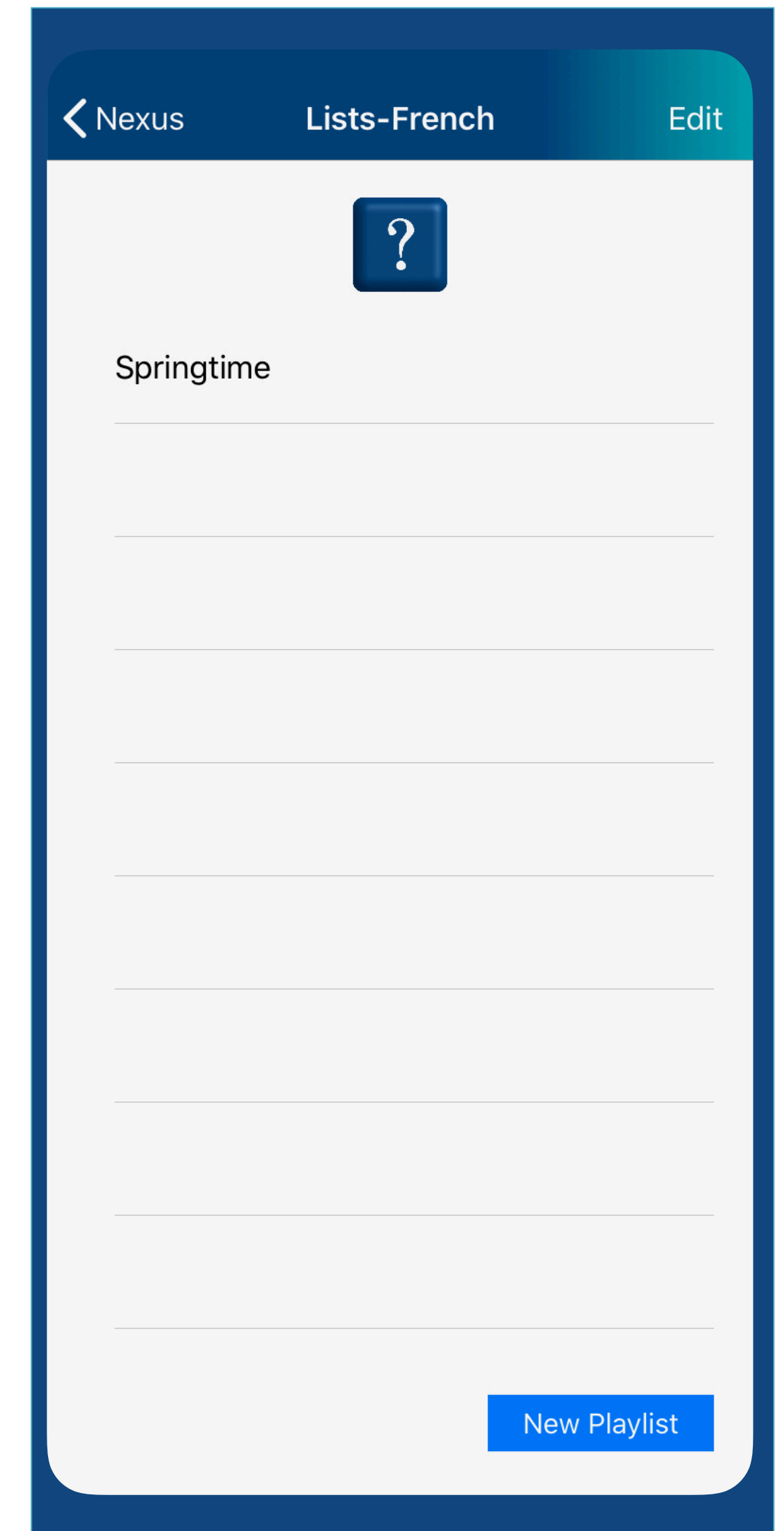




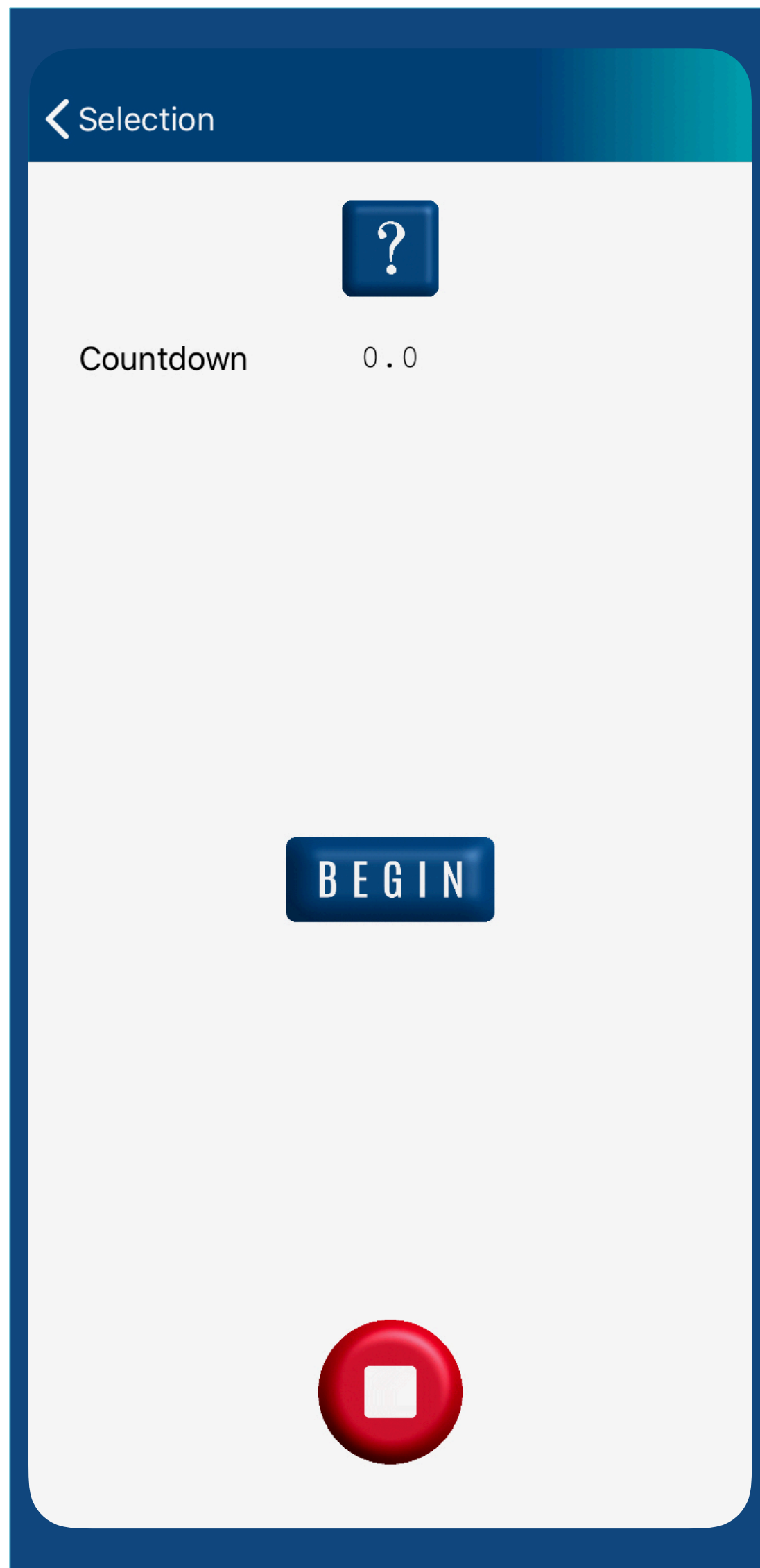
When recording is complete,

The vocals are processed and

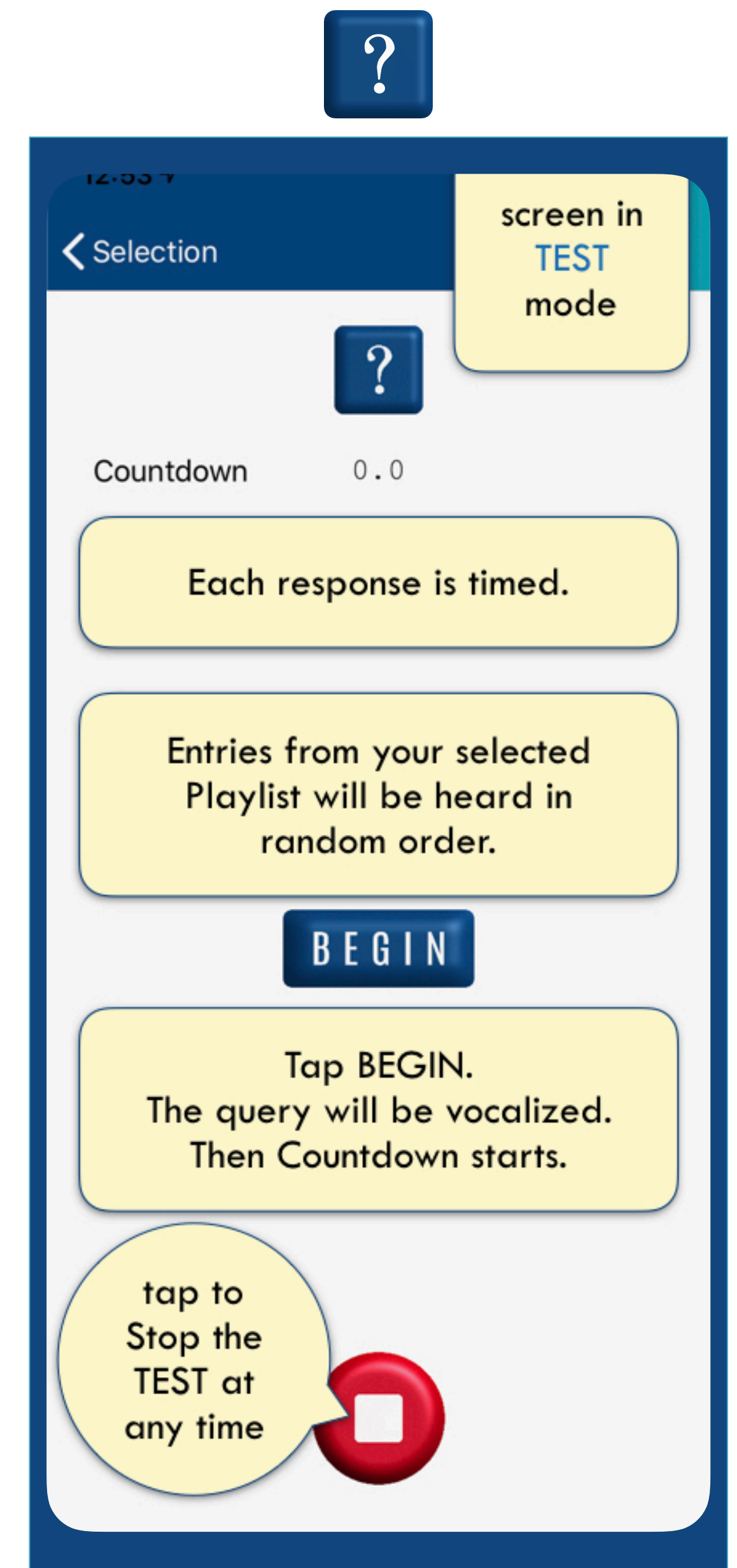


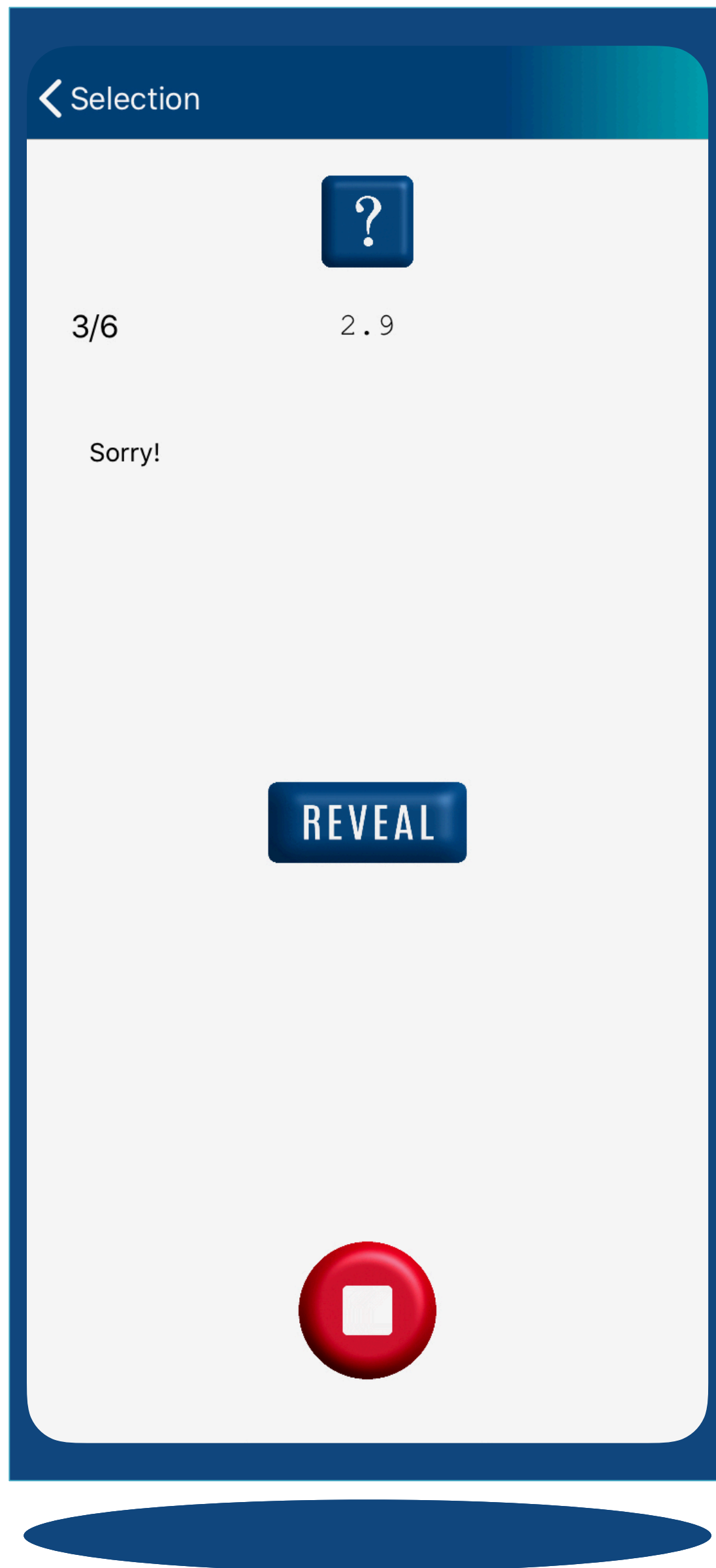
## The TEST function

When you are ready, use the TEST function to check your speed of recall.

Each entry from your selected playlist will be played in random order.

Each response is timed.  
Tap BEGIN to see the first entry.





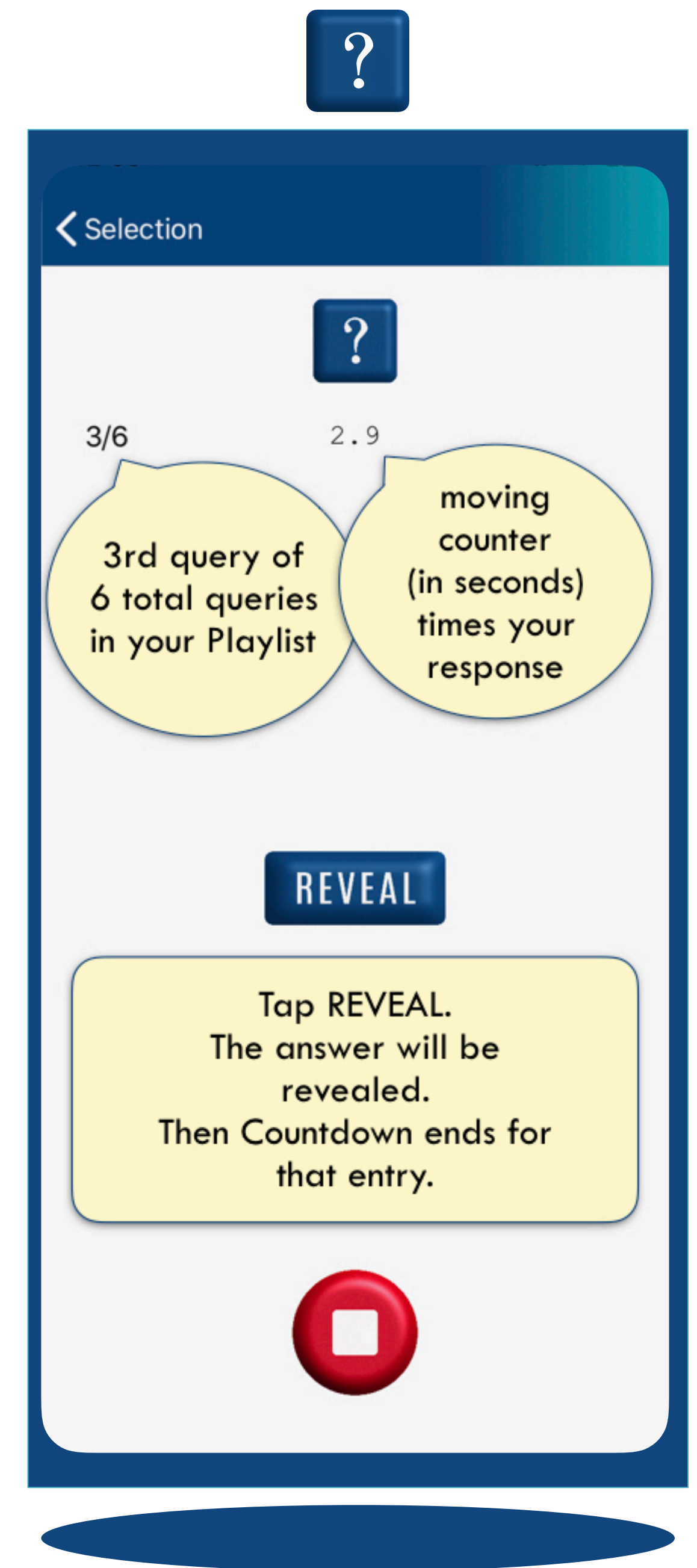
The TEST function (continued)

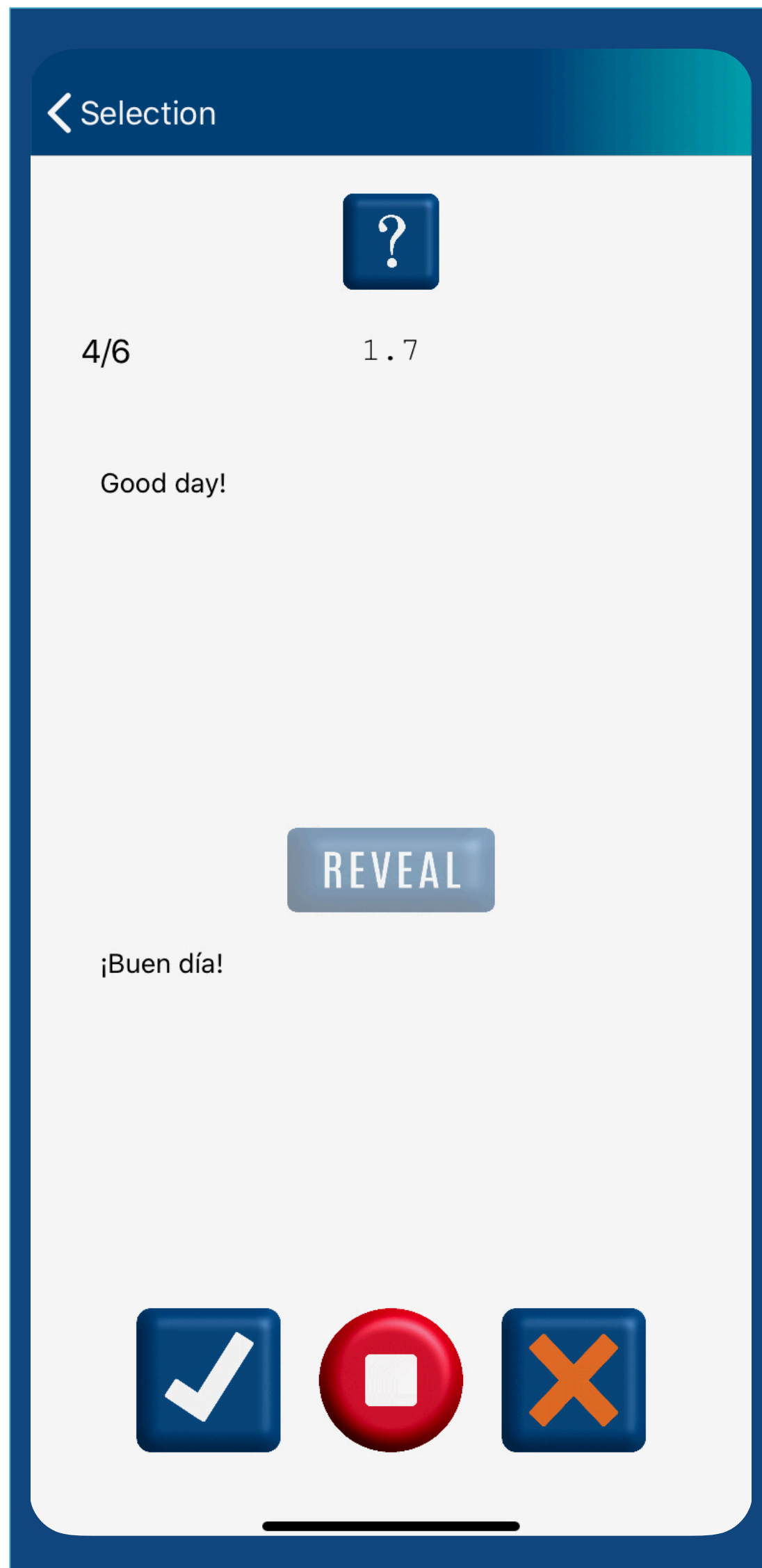
The counter continues as you think of how to translate the entry and then speak it aloud.

Once you have spoken out your response, tap REVEAL.

The countdown for that entry stops and the actual entry text is revealed.

You may end the test at any time by tapping the red stop button.



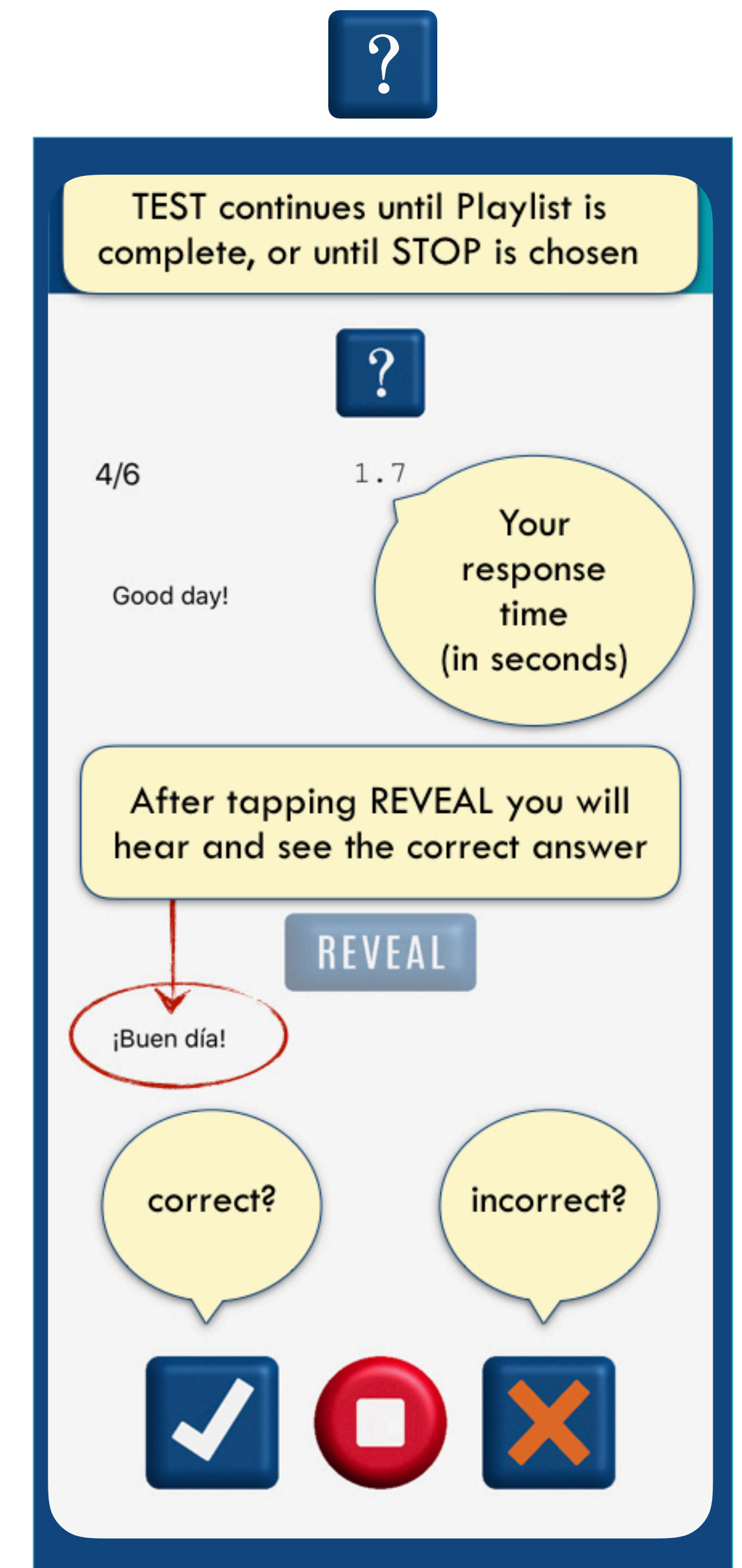


## The TEST function (continued)

Once the correct answer has been revealed, you decide if your own response was correct or incorrect.

Tap the check for a correct answer.  
Tap the X for an incorrect answer.

These answers will be color-coded in your playlist so you can easily see which entries you need to practice.







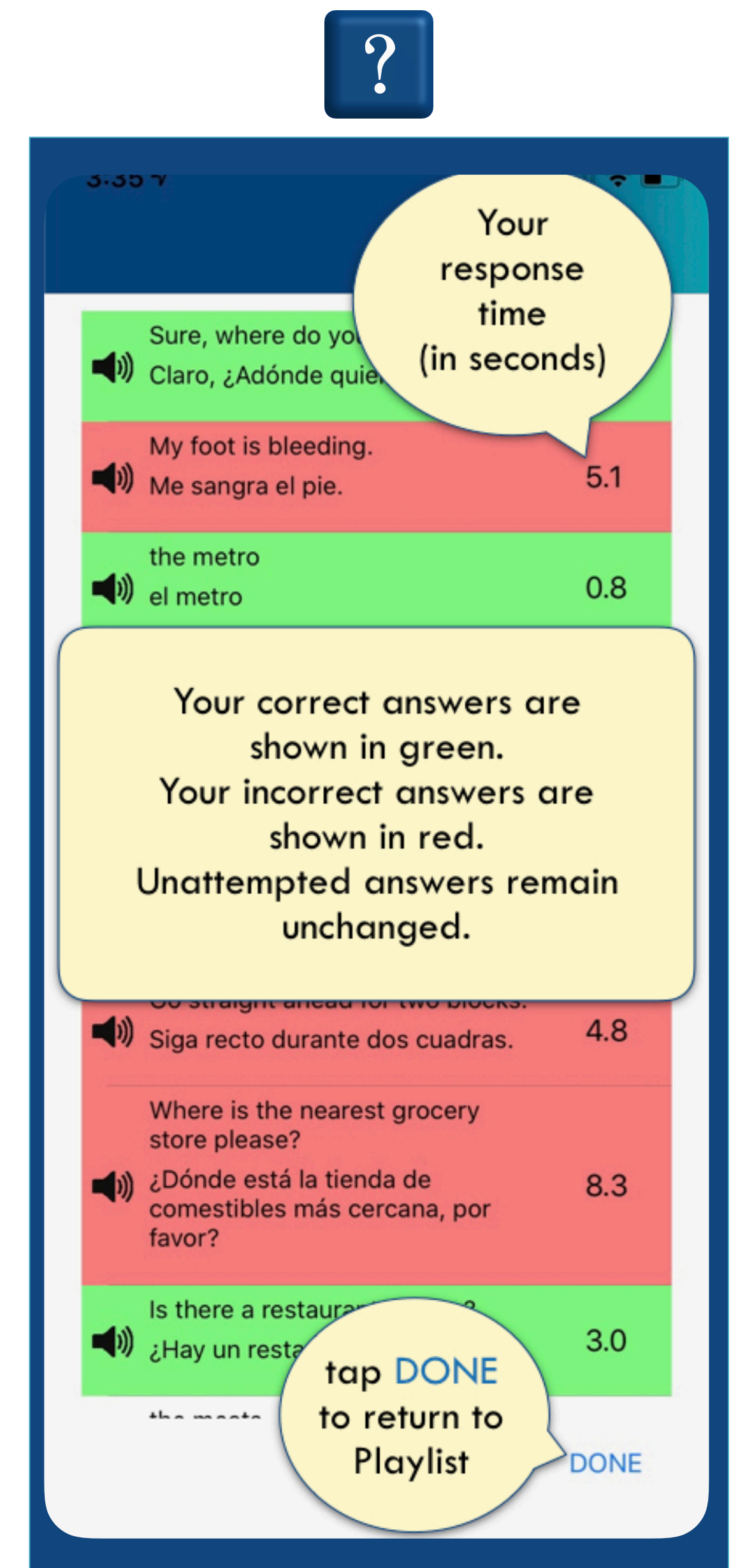

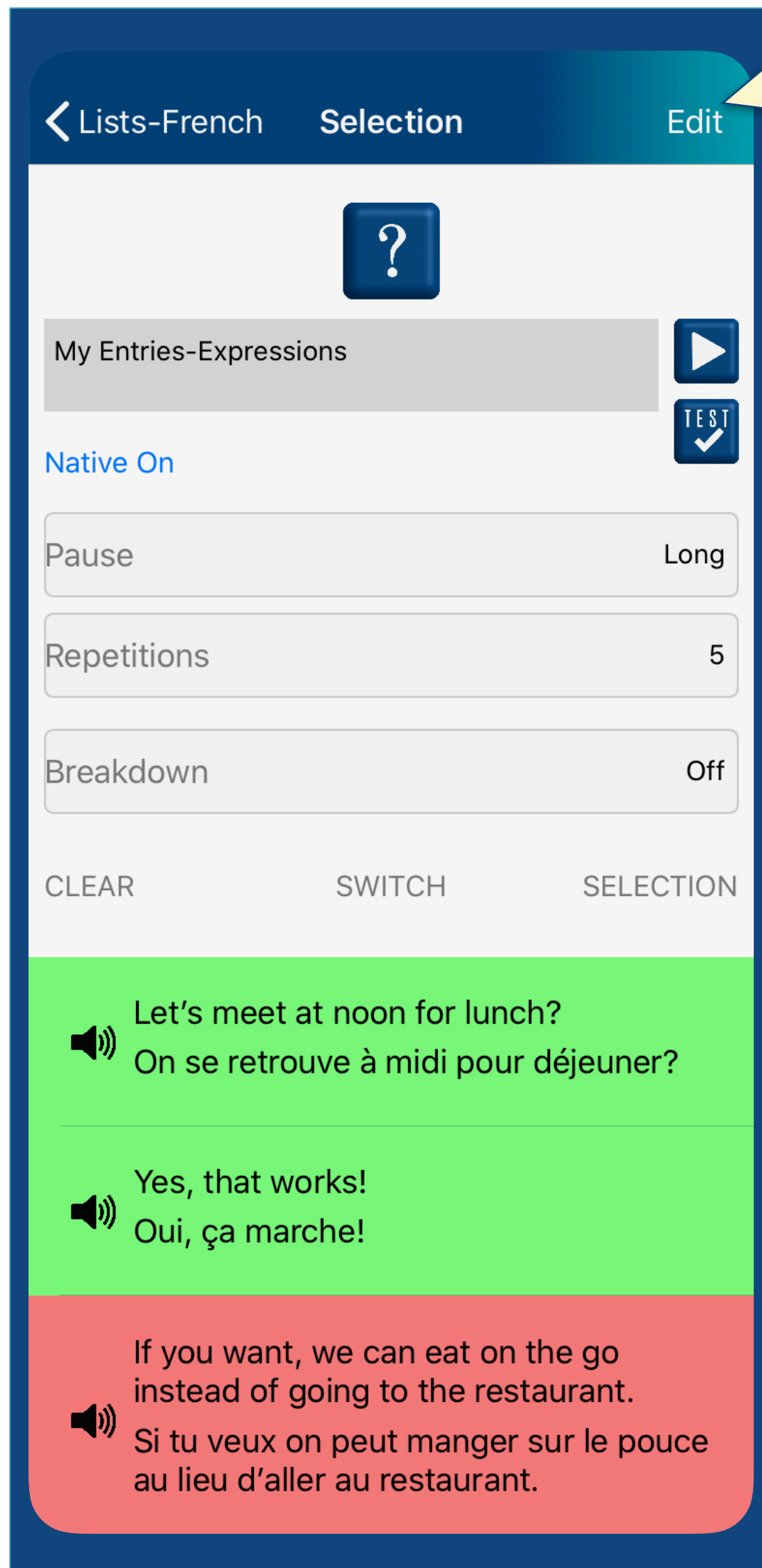
When the test has ended, tap the stop icon.

You may review your responses. Correct answers are shown in green. Incorrect answers are shown in red.

Unattempted answers remain unchanged.

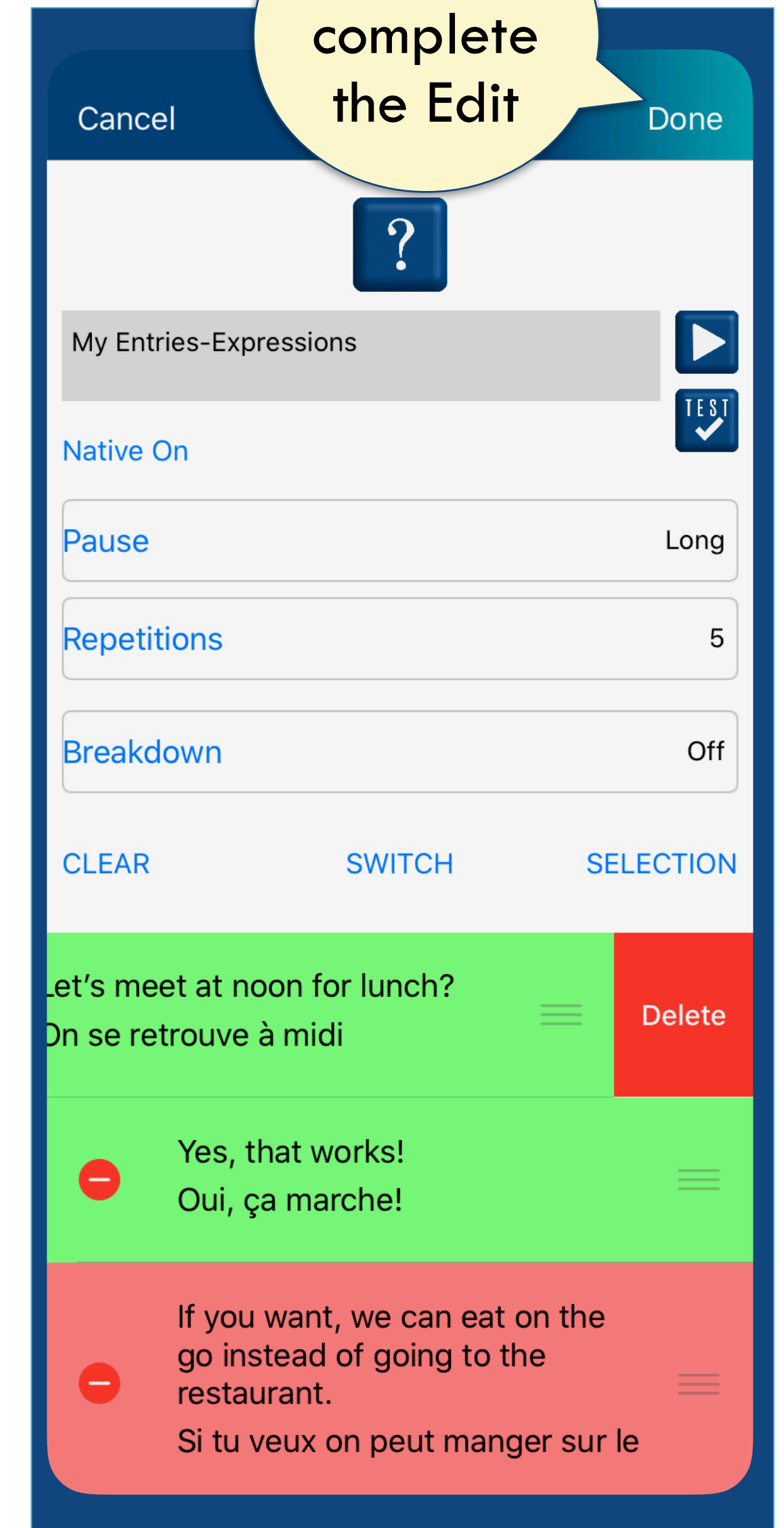

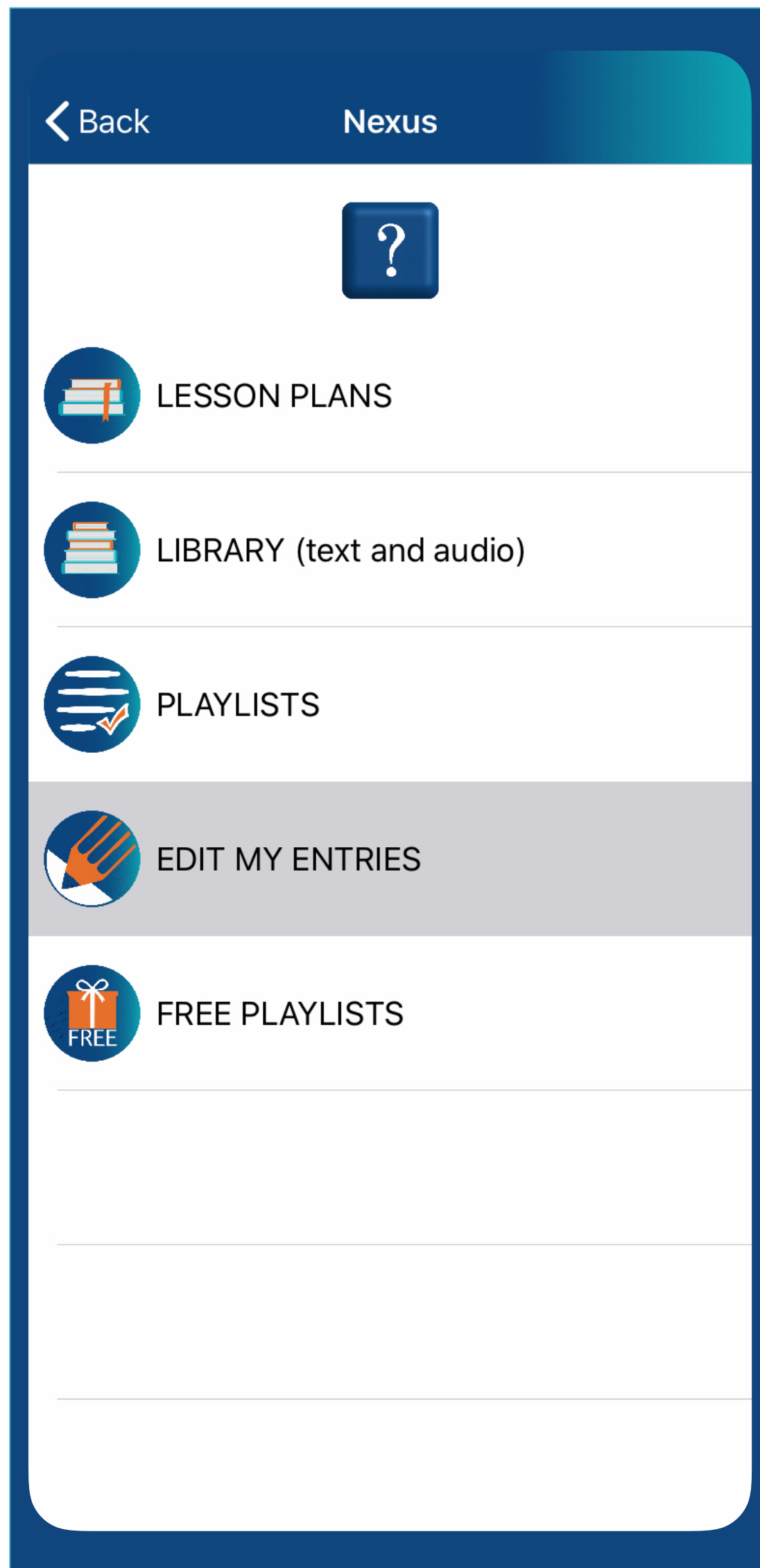

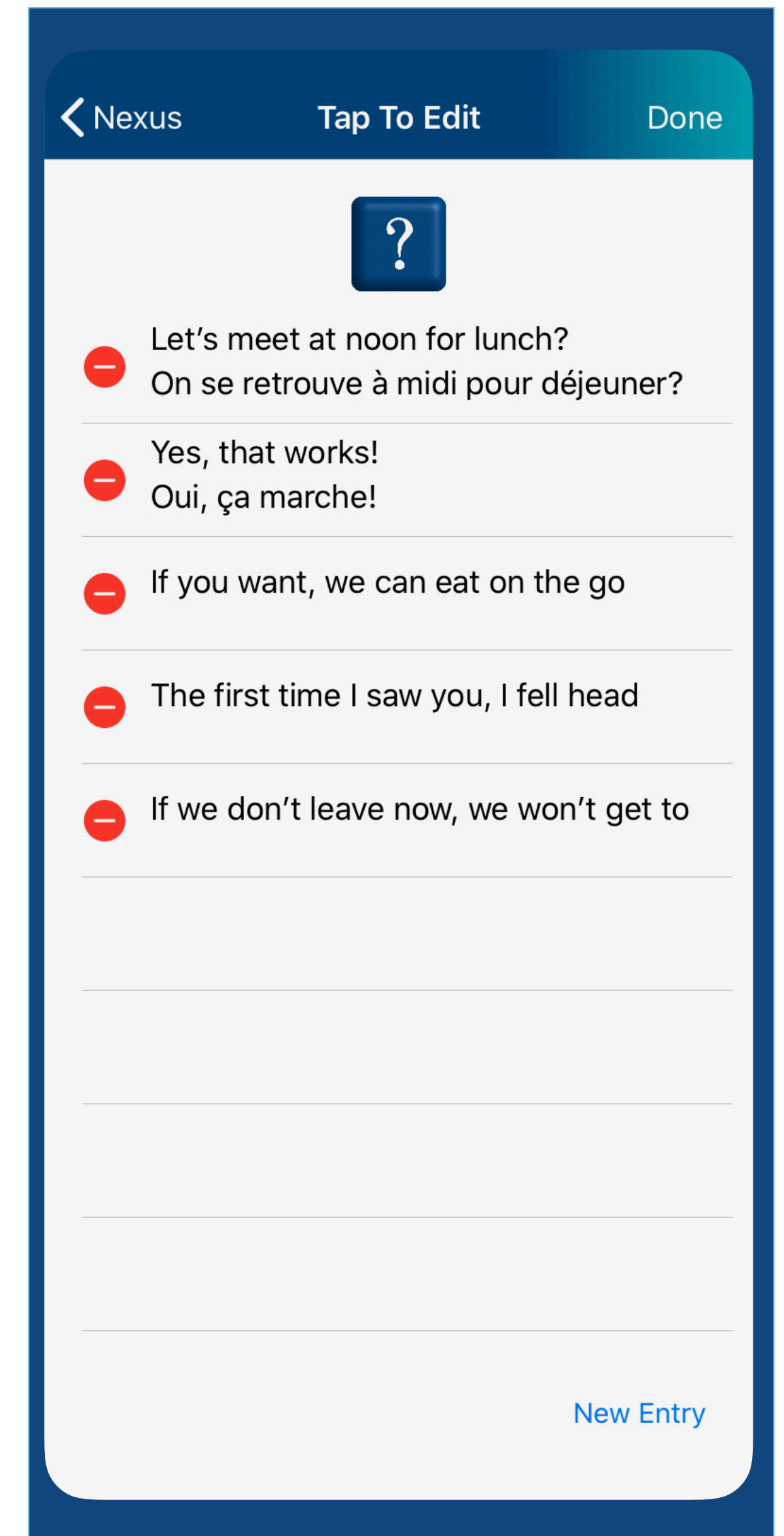
